- ① People unanimously complained poor irrigation service & transport facilities.
- ② People also demanded the basic civic needs viz Hospital, Bank, A.H dispensary & CSC. Khospora to Regar Road, Khospora to Handpura road which were earlier reflected but have not been addressed.
- ③ The VO convinced people to demand only those works which are not related to policy matters and don't need a huge cost. In general public meeting few works were prioritised by the people & B.R.I. which are listed as under:
- I Culvert with P-Bund near cement bridge at wooden Mohalla.
 - II LT Poles 13 nos for Dangepora & Asthan Mohalla.
 - III Repairs/renovation of M/s Building Khospora
 - IV Facilitation of road from Khospora to Zangpora
 - V Construction of Drain at Asthan Mohalla.
 - VI Construction of bath from main road to Jarbel at Khospora.
