I. <u>Major Complaints (Gurseer/ Jagir Ghat)</u>	
(i)	No drinking water facility available at Jagir Ghat. People of Jagir Ghat are consuming contaminated water from River Jehlum on daily basis. So sanction of Water Supply Scheme for the said area on immediate basis is the need of hour. The work on Water Tanky sanctioned on identified land at Jagir Ghat is also required to be started on immediate basis.
(ii)	Electric wire is installed on willow and poplar logs on most of the places. So there is urgent requirement and installation of sufficient number of electric poles in the whole panchayat, so as to avoid any mishap.
(iii)	No connectivity between Jagir Ghat and Gurseer. Till bridge on River Jehlum is completed, <u>one boat is required to be made available for the people of Gram Panchayat for crossing the river.</u>
(iv)	Most of the departments like Handicrafts, Sericulture, Cooperative, Science Technology , Handloom, Youth Services and Sports are not contributing in the overall development of the Gram Panchayat.
(v)	The Panchayat Ghar has its own building in the premises of Middle School Gurseer, which adversely affects the education of students. So relocation of Panchayat Ghar on immediate basis is required and demanded by all the people of Gram Panchayat.
(vi)	Jammu and Kashmir Bank has not participated in the two days outreach Programme.
<u>II. Major/ urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:</u>	
The details as above have already been given under the relevant columns of the booklet. In addition to the earlier demands made during B1V1, B2V2 and B3V3, the people again demanded for the following:-	
(i)	Upgradation of High School Gurseer to Higher Secondary School has again been strongly demanded by the people of GP.
(ii)	Science laboratory and sufficient number of computers (full sets) with internet facility is required in the High School Gurseer. The Computer and internet facility will help the students to access the E-kitab kosh, an initiative of the government about online digital literacy.
(iii)	Fencing of High School especially on the river side on immediate basis and

	renovation or relocation of old underutilized buildings in the school premises.
(iv)	Water connection for Gurseer at Amargarh is required on immediate basis. The concerned officer of the department has also agreed for the same. The appropriate steps are required to be taken in this behalf by the department.
(v)	There is urgent requirement of operationalization of the NTPHC from Sub Centre Gurseer, till land is identified and building is constructed for the same. The BMO present during the Gram Sabha has agreed for the same. So therefore appropriate steps are required to be taken by the Health Department.
(vi)	Completion of Filtration Plant and bridge connecting with Jagir Ghat on immediate basis, so as to lessen the sufferings of the people.
(vii)	To make one boat available for connecting people of the Gram Panchayat (Gurseer with Jagir Ghat) on immediate basis till bridge is completed.
(viii)	Establishment of Panchayat Ghar outside Middle School.
(ix)	Sufficient number of electric poles for Gurseer and Jagir Ghat are also required on most immediate basis.
(x)	Establishment of Sub Centre (Health Department) at Jagir Ghat also demanded by the people of said areas.
(xi)	Centre from Handicrafts Departments for SHG and the girls of the area.
(xii)	Development of sports play ground for youth of the area.

III. Overall Assessment of Visiting Officer.	
	There is Lack of coordination between various departments in overall development of the GP. The people though hailed the initiative of the Government but has requested that the demands put forth during previous B2V programmes are not being implemented on ground.. The urgent public requirements as mentioned in detail hereinabove are required to be fulfilled on most immediate basis. The appropriate steps are also required to be taken to shorten the gap between the general public and the panchayat body so that people can actively participate in panchayat activities. District Officers of all the essential departments should be advised to visit the villages on rotational basis to listen and address the issues of public on spot. The employees of all the line department should adopt people friendly approach. They should be advised to be part of solution and not part of problem on the ground.
