

Sub: Application for seeking your kind attention towards a matter of concern certain encroachments have taken place on the banks of river Jhelum near foot bridge Karnabal to Pantla Chowk also certain miscreants have encroached upon by building houses thus causing great deal of discomfort to the localities of the area and also contractors involved in sale of sand near summerbugh area have built ramps at the edges of the river which is again causing damage to the river bund which may lead to devastating floods.

Respected Sir,

With due reverence and humble submission I along with my body would like to seek your kind attention towards the following few lines with regard to the above cited subject:-

- 1) That it has been observed by us and the people of our Panchayat that encroachments by some miscreants have taken place in and around the river Jhelum banks which may lead to devastating floods in future thus posing a great danger to the entire population of the area.
- 2) That again near foot bridge which is connecting Karnabal to Pantla Chowk certain miscreants have built houses which again is causing a threat to the very existence of the bridge thus may hamper the movements of the people crossing over the bridge besides may lead to great danger in future.
- 3) That also we have found contractors involved in sand business have built ramps which are failing in the river Jhelum may result in damage to the river bund thus damaging embankments of the river.

In view of the facts mentioned above I along with my body recommend immediate evacuation of the illegal structures in and around the area of river Jhelum besides the sand contractors may also be refrained from causing damage to the river bund so that future apprehensions of huge floods is avoided to a great deal and the people of the area are allowed to live in peace along with their families besides a protection to their properties is also provided.


