

After visiting Panchayat East Barwal (B2V4 program), it was observed that the people were enthusiastic and keenly participated in B2V4 program and put forth their demands for various development issues of Panchayat and also reviewed with them the progress of demands of previous B2V programs that, why there are not fulfilled or which are in progress.

It is suggested that there should be better coordination among General public, Govt. officials concerned and PRI members for overall development of Panchayat and for proper awareness and implementation of all centrally sponsored schemes (CSS) for better and equitable development of people at grass root.
