C: MAJOR DEMANDS OF PEOPLE OF UTTERPORA AND RANKIPORA:

- 1 Construction, repairment and upgradation of all the link roads of Utterpora. And roads from Utterpora to Ranki pora through channa mohalla.
- 2 Construction of bridge / culvert from Govt primary school channa mohalla to Sonaullah najar
- 3 Improvement of electric networking system, Replacement of old L.T line by new L.T electric line and installation of new electric poles Ranki pora to utterpora through chann mohalla.
- 4 Drinking water to rankipora and utterpora along with bhat mohalla Rankipora. Renovation of kiker sing and saroop sing road.
- 5 Construction of retaining wall, protection bund near land of Gulam hassan najor and protection

bund near the house of Abdul Rashid Najar for stopping of landslides. Moreover, construction of drain near the house of Gh. Hassan, Gh. Ahmad and Gh Mohiuddin Najar. Utter pora.


- 6 Furniture and utensils for all the aganwadi centres of utterpora and Rankipora, moreover sufficient quantity of fuel should be made available to aganwadi centres for cocking.
- 7 Construction of drain from passenger shed to house of Ghulam Mohd Para at Rankipora.
