GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

Overall assessment of the visit and Suggestions.

So far as the assessment is concerned there is a lot of scope for good governance in 4.P. Ag all the départments are functioning in average manner except few. There is a need for regular checks and inspections and maintainance of record on part of Block/ Tehsil officers, and the same should be provided at G.P. level For this an office of record of all development works should be kept at 4.P. office. I would also like to suggest that on priority basis extension of Road project should be initiated as 80 percent of G.P. is lacking road connectivity. As an immediate relief an extension counter of FCI food outlet must be sanctioned at Village Pranzil, the last Stop of road so that the ST population which have to cover 17-20 kms by fort to collect the Ration may be reduced by 8 to 9 kms by road. Immediate provision of Staff and filling of vacant post at NTPHC Sigdi.



Summary points for Development aspect in B2V4

- 1. Development of Draman Nar as Tourist destination which will create self employment in 4.P, the only tourist attraction nearest to the road about 200 mts.
- 2. Development of infrastructure at Ziavat Sharief at Ward No. 7 for communal brother hood.
- 3. Development of Playground at Markhar and Deenkujan in 4.P.
- 4. Foot bridge at Eidgah Sigdi on Nallah
- 5. Strengthening of irrigation and watershed projects whose saturation is zero in 4.P
