GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions.

So far as the assessment is concerned there is a lot of scope for good governance in E.P. As all the departments are functioning in average manner except few. There is a need for regular checks and inspections and maintainance of record on part of Block/Tehsil officers, and the same should be provided at E.P. level. For this an office of record of all development works should be kept at E.P. office. I would also like to suggest that on priority basis extension of Road project should be initiated as 80 percent of E.P. is lacking road connectivity. As an immediate relief an extension counter of FCI food outlet must be sanctioned at Village Pranzil, the last stop of road so that the ST population which have to cover 17-20 kms by foot to collect the Ration may be reduced by 8 to 9 kms by road. Immediate provision of staff and filling of vacant post at NTPHC Sigdi.



Summary points for Development aspect in B₂V₄

1. Development of Draman Nar as Tourist destination which will create self employment in E.P, the only tourist attraction nearest to the road about 200mts.
2. Development of infrastructure at Ziarat Sharief at Ward No. 7 for communal brotherhood.
3. Development of Playground at Markhar and Deenkujan in E.P.
4. Foot bridge at Eidgah Sigdi on Nallah
5. Strengthening of irrigation and watershed projects whose saturation is zero in E.P
