Detailed Report of Visiting Officer viz. Overall
Assessment with Suggestions

Panchayat - Ludna
Block - Gundna

Date of visit :- 30 Oct - 2022 to 31 Oct - 2022.

During the two days visit of Panchayat as part of B2 V4 the following important observations were made:-

- 1) The condition of Govt. Schools is very poor. The schools in Gujjar basti and Sheikhpur does not even have doors, matting, roof etc.
- 2) There is shortage of electric poles in almost all wards of Panchayat. Electric supply wires (LT) are connected through the trees which may be dangerous many times to the locals.
- 3) There is shortage of drinking water in Panchayat especially in Ward 7, Ward 6 and Ward 3.
- 4) During rains there is flooding in many naalas which stops the way for school going students particularly in Ward no. 2 and Ward no. 5.
- 5) There is school in Bashi (UPS) which is in forest land and no trees are in that area. The forest dept. is not allowing the school to repair the damaged kitchen and bath room.

Suggestions

- 1) The school infrastructure needs to be improved.
- 2) Electric poles should be provided to the Panchayat to safeguard the security of people and avoid the faults in electric supply.
- 3) The water line should be brought to the Panchayat from outside to solve the problem of water shortage.
- 4) Bridges to be built in much needed wards.
- 5) Problem of UPS Bashi needs to be addressed by making suitable delegation with forest department.
