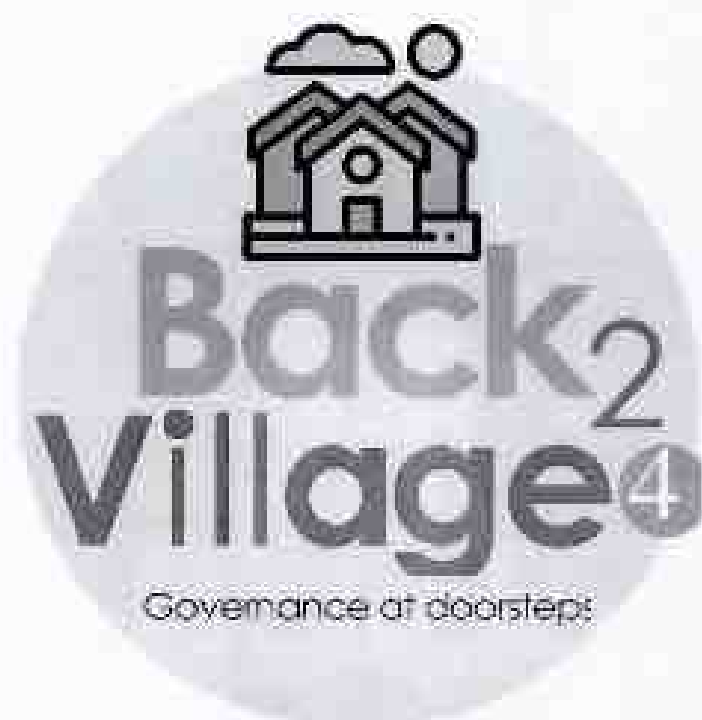

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officers shall refrain himself/herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any work or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DC and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans.
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that at least one KID official/ideally Panchayat Secretary is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officers should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

I) Any major problem brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer

1. The drop out rate for pursuing studies after 8th standard will reduce if Panchayat is provided proper road connectivity and Middle School Kandyar of the Panchayat is upgraded to High School.
2. Nonavailability of Playground for the Youth.
3. Road connectivity from Treen to Meyari via KupadSullah.
4. Road connectivity from backside of Narayana Hospital to MurrahNali Bred.
5. Non functional Primary School Lower Treen as Teacher posted there is not attending her duties from the last four years as she has married in Kashmir as a result the enrolment in the school has reduced. People want that action be taken under relevant service rules.
6. Non responsive / consultative attitude of Irrigation Department / Jal Shakti/ PMGSY and PDD.
7. Pathway from Meyari to Meyari Nallah ShamshanGhat.
8. The Panchayat wants its area under Division Reasi as Panchayat is located in Reasi District. The PMGSY Division Udhampur is not responsive and neither care for the Panchayat functionaries
9. Badminton Court in Government Middle School Kandyar.

II) Major / urgent pubic demands that was / were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far

1. Making functional the Lift Irrigation Scheme from Kandyar Nallah. If this scheme is made functional, the farmers income especially belonging to SC community will be raised.
2. Road connectivity as mentioned in follow up of

B2V programme from time to time.

III) Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions

1. The Panchayat though located very near to the National Highway remained highly neglected for years together in comparison to even most remotest Panchayats. It needs to be adopted as the Model Panchayat so that the innocent residents of Panchayat have the benefits of government developmental program. To reduce the drop out rate of students especially girls / to assure that pregnant women reach nearest hospital in time for institutional delivery / to minimize migration of locals from Panchayat, the Panchayat besides road connectivity needs one High School, visit of officers of Jal Shakti to recheck the plans made under the JJM in consultation to Gram Panchayat so that objective of JJM is fulfilled and Panchayat gets its share. Further, senior officers of PDD should also visit the Panchayat to assess the negligence done during SOUBHAGYA scheme and to take remedial measures in consultation with Gram Panchayat. Similarly, the senior officers of Irrigation & FC should also visit the Panchayat and examine the Lift Irrigation Plant which remained neglected leading to non utilization of the assets developed by the Government for the benefit of poor farmers.
