# General Assessment of the Visiting Officer (B2V4)

## I) Major Complaints:-

- (i) Water Supply for drinking by the PHE deptt. is not satisfactory due to leakage of old supply pipe lines & almost insufficient for the Panchayat as a whole.
- (ii) Safai Karam chori not provided to the Panchayat & Health Sub centres for their maintainability.
- (iii) Facility of khitmat centre / CSC is not satisfactory due non-availability of Internet connection in the Panchayat.
- (iv) Medical Staff & Ambulance is <sup>not</sup> provided by the concerned Deptt in the Pkt.
- \* (v) In Govt H.S.S. Pallenwale, the building is not sufficient as per the School enrolment, it required separate two examination Halls, one room for e-library & one room for smart class urgently as the school has already received equipments & materials. In addition, one separate washroom (toilet) for girls required in the school.
- (vi) Labour card should be prepared & issued at Block head Qtr.
- (vii) PHE daily wger have not got their salary for the last 4 months.
- (viii) The major concern of Pkt is regarding issuance of new ration cards & Land Pass books.
- (ix) Regarding issuance of domicile certificate & Nagal are not issued in time bound manner.
- (x) Regarding PDD deptt, there is urgent need of repairing of old electric wire.
- (xi) PMAY is not issued to any person in the Pkt since 2016-17.

## II) Major / Urgent Public demands :-

- (i) Construction of new building of PHE Pallenwale as the old building is declared unsafe by the PDD deptt.
- (ii) Leveling of Play ground near Pkt Ghar & Renovation of Park at Chinota (Chondharnwale).
- (iii) The CSC / khitmat centre should be made functional at Pkt Ghar with full implementation of fibre internet connection.
- (iv) Two culverts urgently required in the Pkt, one at Shemshan Ghat & other at between chandharnwale & Romali link.

### (III) Overall Assessment & Suggestions

- (i) Drinking Water Supply is very poor in the Pgt, due to leakage of old pipes, it should be rectified immediately & so that the public gets basic necessity of life.
- (ii) The Internet facility like fibre connection should be made available in the Pgt Ghar so that, the public get the benefit of all the schemes implemented in the Pgt level.
- (iii) In Govt H.S.S. Pallonwale, there is a urgent need of more accommodation for setting the apparatus & other materials already received by the school pertaining to e-library & smart class rooms. In addition two examination Hall are also required.
- (iv) Regarding Land Pass books & issuance of new Ration cards to the public should be resolved at Block Head Qtr. Samson. Labour card should be made available in the Tehsil HQ.
- (v) PMAY Case should be sanctioned urgently in the Pgt which is figured about 50 as since 2016-17 to till date no single case has been sanctioned in the Pgt.
- (vi) Construction of new building for PHC Pallonwale is urgently required as it is functioning in Pgt Ghar Pallonwale.
- (vii) Leveling of Play ground & Park renovation & construction of two culverts are urgent works required by the Pgt.
- (viii) One Shemshan Ghat (Cremation ground) should be constructed at Bandonwale as the land is available.
- IX Old/damaged Electric wire should be replaced immediately as these are unsafe for the local public.
- (X) One Community Hall is main requirement at Bandonwale for common public use in the Pgt Pallonwale.
