GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to adminis- trative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- 7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
- 8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISTING OFFICER

Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:

The people in the GP complained that the demands put forward by them during the previous B2V programmes have not yet been fulfilled by the government. They prayed that the earlier demands put forward by them may be fulfilled at an earliest to make B2V programme a success. There is dire need of water supply scheme for uncovered households and filtration plant for the whole GP under 'Har Ghar Jal' initiative. There is also need for new electric poles (HT/LT) and fresh transmission wire in the GP to cover the area where there is threat to life and property. Link roads viz Bozgam to Devsar, Agroo to Kilam and Agroo to Devsar need to be constructed at an earliest for the development of the GP. Irrigation channels viz Padshah Ladh, Makhpath Ladh, Khahgund Ladh, etc. be restored, drudged and rejuvenated. All the pathways in the GP need to be constructed.





II Major/ urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

The major/urgent public demands are as follows:

- 1. Construction of roads from Bozgam to Devsar, Agroo to Kilam, Agroo to Banghal and Agroo to Devsar under PMGSY.
- 2. Construction of Water Filtration Plant for safe and pure drinking water.
- 3. Restoration, drudging & rejuvenation of Padshah Ladh, Makhpath Ladh & Khahgund Ladh.
- 4. Construction of Panchayat Ghar and Patwar Khana in the GP.
- 5. Construction of Playground in the GP.
- 6. Establishment of veterinary outlet in the GP.
- 7. Construction of building for health sub centre at Agroo and establishment of immunization centre at Bozgam.
- 8. Construction of link roads viz main road to Barzool Nard, Jinazgah to Kanipath (house of Gh Mohd Lone) and Lonepora to Band saw, Najar Mohalla to Ganie Mohalla in village Bozgam.
- 9. Construction of CSCs at Lone Mohalla Masjid Bozgam, Jamia Masjid Agroo and Eidgah Bozgam and fencing of Grave yard at Agroo.
- 10. Construction of new building for MS Bozgam and Boundary wall for MS Agroo.
- 11. Construction of protection bundhs near; i. land of Sayar Ahmad Najar (Bozgam), ii. Panzwouth near land of Gull Mohd Lone (Bozgam), iii. house of Mohd Yousuf Bhat & others (Agroo), iv. Hanjwarda land of Abdul Salam Mir (Agroo), v. houses of Gh Nabi Ahanger & others (Agroo), vi. Dumbkhah land of Gh Nabi Bhat (Agroo), vii. Dudhwouth land of Ab Rehman Bhat (Agroo) and viii. land of Ab Majeed Sheikh (Agroo).
- 12. Construction of lanes; i. Jamia Masjid to house of Ab Majeed Sheikh (Agroo), ii. Hardchoun to house of Gh Mohd Bhat (Bozgam), and iii. house of Ab Salam Shair to house of Gull Mohd Shair (Bozgam).
- 13. Passenger shed on main road near MS Bozgam.
- 14. Construction of drain from Sherkhud to house of Ab Rehman Dar (Agroo).

Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:

B2V4 programme was held in a healthy environment in which people participated whole heartedly. During the visit different line department functionaries made people aware about the schemes of their departments for generating self-employment and transforming the society from dependent to self-reliant. People in the GP have access to various e-services launched by the government through CSC. People suffer badly due to non-availability of Filtration Plant for drinking water. Youth have no playground to keep themselves fit. Construction of Filtration Plant is the need of the hour. There should be a play field for the youth. There is also need for establishment of sewing and embroidery or carpet weaving centre for the women folk to make them sound and self-sufficient economically and socially.
