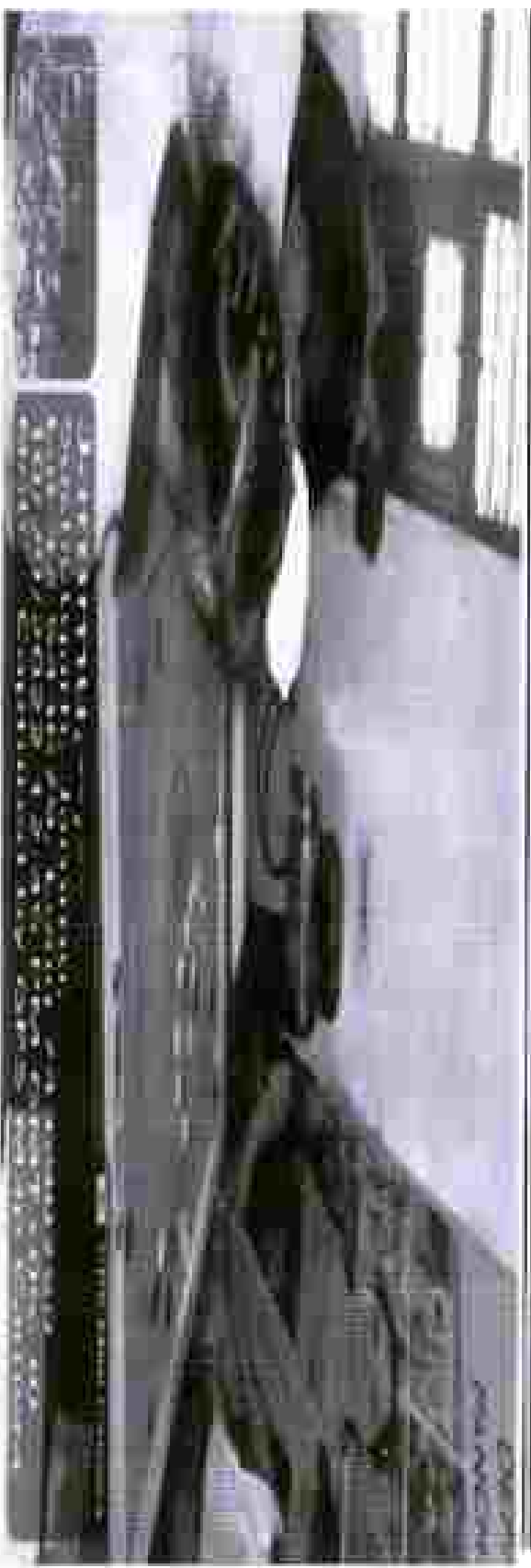

These people needed one time mutual settlement of their land records. Being Government servant and visiting officer to the panchayat, I suggested that there should be a committee formed on different levels(DC, DIV COMM, Administration level) that resolve the non existing land record issues with one time mutual settlement based on grandfather and great grandfather's ownership records.

- As govt. is proposing to develop Gharana village as tourist spot because of its nation wide popularity of wetland(visiting thousands of species of birds), People are

People are ready to left their places/land chunks but in place of their land chunks they want alternate chunk of land in adjoining areas for their survival.
