1. Any major complaint brought to the notice of Visiting Officer,

The major complaints brought to the notice of Visiting officers are as under:-

- ① Drinking water scarcity
- ② Electricity poles installation and cutdowns
- ③ Internal road connectivity
- ④ Unemployment.
- ⑤ Duplicated condition of PS Balli, MS Kundu.
- ⑥ Operation of PS Sudhar, PS Chakra ~~operation~~ from private building.
- ⑦ Substandard work execution by contractors.
- ⑧ Operation of Anganwadi Centres from private buildings.
- ⑨ Non operation of Kundu Kue by Irrigation & Flood Control Dept.


② Most urgent demands that were reflected earlier but have not been addressed.

- ③ Drinking water scarcity
- ④ Repair of PS Balli & MS Kundu.
- ⑤ Foot bridge at Gourbari.
- ⑥ Electricity pole installation (HT/LT) poles in all wards
- ⑦ Internal road connectivity to all wards

③ Overall assessment of the visit & Suggestions

Overall assessment of the visit is very good. All the PRIs and Locals participated in the B2V4 programme. Ward sabhar and Gram Sabha was attended by large No. of the public and local PRIs. Many frontline Department officials also participated. The Locals and PRIs showed disappointment over the fulfillment of ^{at} their

demands raised during the B2V1, B2V2 & B3V3 programme. Large No. of demands were raised with respect to the repair of PS Balli & MS Kundi which are in dilapidated condition which needs to be addressed urgently. Two schools i.e. PS ~~Khesha~~ Sildham & PS Chakwa are operating from private buildings. The buildings of these schools needs immediate construction. There is also water scarcity in the area though water connection though water connection is available in almost every house. The issue needs to be addressed though one JTM project Karal-Kundi has been sanctioned which will benefit ward No. 8, 6, 7 & 5. The internal road connectivity is one of the major issue which can be fulfilled through construction of the tractor roads. The soil quality of the area supplement with water scarcity are major challenges for the Agriculture sector. Some schemes related to Anardana production, Oleo production, Mushroom Cultivation, Sericulture can uplift the standard of the locals. The awareness at ground level is very poor and data compilation is also very poor by the RDD which needs to be improved and provided to visiting officers so that critical analysis can be done.
