- I. Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: Incomplete culvert at Guriwan/ Road Constructed by PMGSY need repairment (From RajKhul to Namblan)/ Sarpanch behaves rudely with the officials of department (esp. female staff)
- II. Major/urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: Though most of the public demands reflected earlier are urgent & need to be addressed but "Provision of filtered water supply" is the need of the hour & need to be addressed on priority basis.
- III. Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in details along with concrete suggestions)
The overall response of people to attend/participate the B2V4 at Namblan (PH-14) was moderate.
The interaction with the local people led to the fact that the government functionaries are not reaching the people at panchayat level very often, leading to the delay in the works that need to be done on priority basis.
The demands that were brought to the notice in B2V1, B2V2 & B2V3 have either not been approved or the work has not been started yet.
The people were disheartened by the fact that despite their enthusiastic participation in the B2V1, B2V2 & B2V3 the developmental and top priority works in their area have not been started.
There was lack of awareness of various departmental schemes among people in general. The work of the Rural Development Department was found to be exemplary, working harmoniously with the panchayat. It is pertinent to mention that the GRS's, VLW's of Rural Development Department work tirelessly and extend their full support to the people and the panchayat.
In the end, I conclude my report by mentioning that the B2V initiative that the Government has undertaken is a very innovative programme that will lead to the development of the rural areas in an expedited manner and these types of initiatives should be carried out in future as well.
