




- (3) one Kanal land was donated for the construction of panchayat ghar by a person Abdul Rashid mir, till date he was not given any compensation (needs to be resolved)
- (4) Almost 50 kanals land at Narwara needs irrigation supply (needs to be resolved immediately).
- (5) Narwara Area has poor <sup>mobile</sup> network connectivity must be solved on priority basis as online education suffers badly.

→ Employees of various departments should be made more accountable to PRI's

→ Awareness camps about various schemes of the govt should be held frequently.


