### OVER ALL ASSESMENT of VISITING OFFICER

- ① People are very poor but hardworkers as the area is very far away from Bhatt. Headquarters. Agriculture is the only source of income as there is no industrial setup in the area. Despite lot of schemes by the Centre as well as UT govt people are unable to take benefits due to the non-availability of revenue papers. They complain that revenue deptt takes lot of lot in issuing even a nakal moreover revenue deptt ask them to go for online services but most of them are uneducated and labourer.
- ② One very prestigious scheme of water supply was started ~~in~~ in 2013 and still lying incomplete despite spending Rs 1.5 crore.

### Suggestions

→ One revenue camp should be organised in which officers from top to bottom must to present and on spot cases must be settled.

→ Officers/officals of PNE Deptt must be dealt with strict actions as they neither attended the Gram Sabha nor responded on ~~phones~~ as they kept their phones off on the day of visit. As per the order issued by worth DC of Udhampur, no employee would apply for leave the how could they switch off their phones during duties hours.
