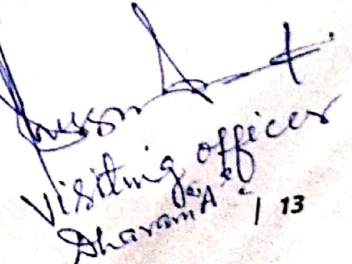

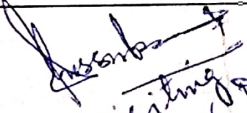

- 1. Daily wages working in many depas. Since long raised the issue of their regularisation and all the people in the Gram Sabha found supporting them.
 - 2. Fencing of Govt. School buildings falling in the Panchayat Dharam "A".
 - 3. Shortage of staff and infrastructure in Govt., High School Dharam; UPS Papashilana etc.
 - 4. Bank Branch not opened till date.
 - 5. MGNREGA Supporting staff is without salary for the last eight months.
 - 6. BDO office has not its own accommodation and running in Panchayat Ghar at Dharam A.

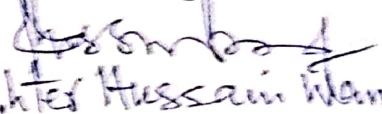
