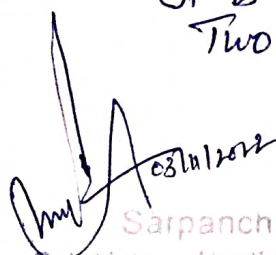

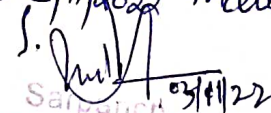

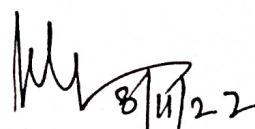

OVERALL ASSESSMENT OF VISIT AND SUGGESTIONS

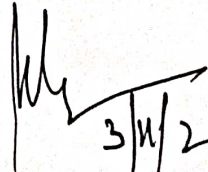
1. ASSESSMENT:-

2. SUGGESTIONS:-
