General Assessment of the visiting officer

- (i) Major Complaints
- (i) Farmers of Pdt. suffered due to damaged water channels due to fear of lining gutting. There is very less discharge of canal water. Moreover, upgradation of Lift Irrigation is required to meet up irrigation problem as one water channel is already damaged and the other one is insufficient to irrigate the area.
- (ii) Farmers of Pdt. suffered due to defective Paddy Seed ^{purchased} received from Agriculture Dept. and demanding compensation.
- (iii) Acute shortage of drinking water was noticed due to damage of water pumping motor and the inhabitants demand a standby pumping machinery at each Tube well Tube well-I, II, Batehra and Simbalanah Str.
- (iv) Inhabitants of the Pdt. are unhappy with the Revenue dept. due to very slow pace of work / casual approach about mutation, illegal and girdawari process. Many farmers are not getting benefits under "Pradhanmantri Sammanvadi Yojana" whose mutation has been done after 2013.
- (v) Delay in renovation of Panchayat Ghar building despite repeated requests to RDO.

(2) Major / Urgent demands

- (i) Upgradation of Lift Irrigation machinery at Batehra alongwith immediate reconstruction / repair of water channels and upgradation of Kul also.
- (ii) Inhabitants of Pdt. are deprived of health services and demand PHCs 24x7. one at Dharmkhoo and Simbalanah each.
- (iii) Development of ~~another~~ play ground near Panchayat Ghar
- (iv) Demand of another Veterinary Hospital in Dharmkhoo alongwith Govt building already running in Potato building at Batehra.
- (v) A passenger shed is required at Tera Talab for passenger convenience.
- (vi) Govt Middle School Dharmkhoo requires immediate attention for construction of new building and filling, levelling of ground and tile work is reqd. as rainwater accumulates due to low area.
- (vii) Street Lights ^{ad solar lights} are required for chowks, streets and Panchayat Ghar.
- (viii) More electric poles with aligned material is required due to upswing of new houses in Pdt. Also HT poles are required for replacement of damaged RE poles. People of Gundwana Batehra locality demand shifting of 10KV Str. from the field to safe place for smooth running of power supply and to avoid any mishap.
- (ix) Old building of Govt High School Batehra is in very dilapidated condition is not worth use and the new building requires immediate repair. Plaster and cement concrete have fallen and steel mesh is exposed.
- (x) Two more new Tubewells alongwith OHT ones at Dharmkhoo, Simbalanah and Batehra are reqd. to meet up the drinking water problem.
- (xi) Construction of community Hall is reqd. at Tera Talab.
- (xii) Construction of new building for Panchayat is urgently required for effective functioning of PRI.
- (xiii) Beautification and tile work is insufficient and requires attention for ^{more} beautification.
- (xiv) Upgradation of road from Batehra to Tera Talab under NABARD.

Overall assessment: Although the PRI is working very hard for the development of Panchayat but newly created but lacks development in many fields. So this Pdt needs more attention. One PRI is hapless due to poor outcome of BSV programmes held earlier. Resentment among public was witnessed because major requirements/demands were not met/considered.
