There is need to sensitize PRIs to know the benefits of such Sabhas.

Enrolment in Govt. Schools is low and encouragement of youth to attend Govt. Schools need to be done. Monkey menace is another issue. Coming to suggestion, the land lying vacant be used for other crops that are not damaged by monkeys like lemon grass. Employment under Govt.
