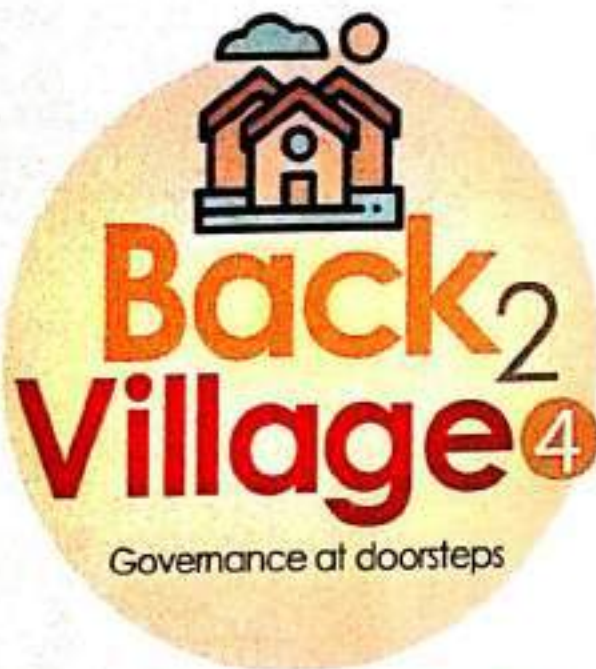

As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.

He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.

While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans

His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.

Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

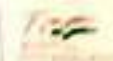

2.	Completion of construction building for Govt. High School Galwanpora, (under construction since 2018) is required in the interest of students.
3.	Public Transport Facility/Sumo service of Panchayat Halqa has been discontinued. The same is required to be restored at an earliest in the public interest.
4.	Irrigation kulhs (Sekh kulh, Gamkulh etc.) of the Panchayat Halqa have been blocked due to encroachments/soil erosion at various places, especially at Jelipora Masjid by residents which is required to be looked into (dredging/de-silting) on priority basis in order to protect water logging/inundation of area during rainy season.
5.	Damaged electric poles and conductors are required to be replaced in the Panchayat Halqa. Installation of additional transformer of 63KW and lighting system requires to be installed at common area.

Now we hope your august hands will look into the matter and do justice with us and our students. We shall be highly obliged to you if your concern is addressed as early as possible.

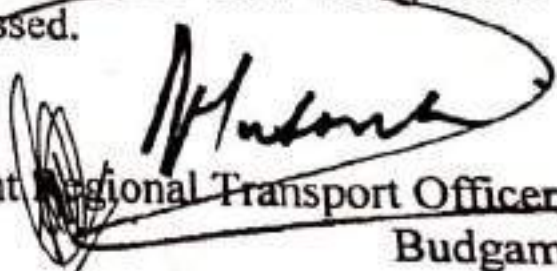
