# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level
  itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on
  www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

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

NAVEENA DEVI Sarpanch Panchayat halqa UPPER MEER have the honour appreciate from the core of my heart to the Governance of His Excellency the Governor Jammu and Kashmir for ; launching the mission BACK2VILLAGE. In this context I would like to invite the kind attention of visiting authorities as under:

#### STATUS OF ROAD

That my panchayat is slacking behind in the matter. Bond facility, presently there is, only one PMGSY Roads in function from main road to Sankri Dev Sthan, which needs to be extended upto another Sankri via Beeran Dabbar to Sankri Cladha Dhar... Moreover there is need of road connectivity of remaining village hamlets, like UPPER MEER TO PATAN, DRAMMAN, GASYAL DEV STHAN, MATA KALA, TO PASSER...

#### DRINKING WATER FACILITY:

That the panchayat is lacking behind in the drinking water supply to the residents and old schemes is in process i.e. FROM BASKAR DHAR TO SANKRI which is need to be upgraded and now there is need for construction of 5 £nons of £medium water tank to cater the need of the locality in drinking water i.e water tank at Sankri, Sarti, Bagra Bass ,Gharian, Chaka kothi as such public is suffering for drinking water supply especially in summers when all natural sources become dry.

#### POWER SUPPLY

That we are thankful to the administration regarding supply of transformers but there is shortage of Electric Poles for electrification of left out houses. Now there is need of three more transformers to be installed at Panthora Gharrian, Marooni and Kattian Sarafti and nearly 150 poles are requested for proper electrification.

#### HEALTH FACILITY

This panchayat is badly sufferer in the field of medical facilities and there is need of SUB CENTRES, at Dramman near pry School and one other at Sankri Kattian , one sub centre for SC area is required at Parson

#### **EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES:** .5.

That there is need to upgrade Pry School Dramman and Middle school Meer Sarti as such these schools have not been upgraded till now even after repeated requests and visits. That there is need of Mobile Pry School at this given area. Further more classes in newly sanctioned Degree college at Panchari so that students of this panchayat can seek admission in college...

#### ECONOMY /LIVELIHOOD.

That this Panchayat is has been neglected in this field and there is no development which can be verified on spot so there is need of special consideration to this point. There is need to start para glidding scheme, Hand loomd centre, Dry fruit storage, cold storage facility, Vocational training centres, herbal stores etc. be given in this area. PM --- AWAS YOJANA BE APPLIED IN LETTER AND SPIRIT FOR THE PUBLIC WHICH HAS BEEN STOPPED FOR THE LAST 4 YEARS.

FEBRURE TO DE

That there is need of 27 small foot bridges over small nallas so that small school going children can be benefitted

#### PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION 8.

That there is no Ration Depot in our village i.e. in UPPER MEER WHICH IS BURNING NEED OF THE LOCALITY AND one SEPRATE RATIONS DEPOT SHOULD BE SANCTIONED IN THE VILLAGE for more than 1750 voters...

#### SKILL DEVELOPMENT 9.

That there is need to give special attention to the Skill Dev. Programme for the betterment of the youth of area.

MIGHTEGA SCHEME 10.

> That there is need to increase the wages of mgnngworkers upto Rs 300\- so that local should not be migrated for job to cities.

PENDING CONSTRUCTIONS WORKS 11.

That there is need to complete the remaining construction works which are left half way.
