GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall visit the Gram Panchayat regularly and offer any constructive criticism of the Government and local institutions in relation to the development issues. As far as possible, his or her observations should be based on a first-hand analytical study among the Panchayat's interaction in the village.
2. The visiting officer shall not be sanctioned any wage or for making any commitment.
3. While preparing village development plan, he/she should ensure that, demand are prioritized and re-foster under available schemes, where necessary, the larger needs are to be referred to other relevant departments. The Panchayat should ensure that all the works are directed to the Panchayat's development plan.
4. His work shall be based on a joint study with the Panchayat members.
5. Every District Commissioner has to ensure that all the Gram Panchayats, especially Panchayats are fully equipped with necessary staff with adequate personal and resources to ensure the effective functioning. Panchayats also need to be trained in the district.
6. The District Officer should ideally, call the Panchayat to complete the reports at the Panchayat level. After that, the reports should be signed both by the Panchayat and by the District Officer in the presence of the Panchayat members.
7. District Officer should ensure that, the Panchayat members are fully aware of the schemes and the activities during the visit and return to them.
8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas:
 - a. Allocation of central, sponsored schemes
 - b. Subsidies of individual and group schemes
 - c. Self-employment schemes
 - d. Self-employment schemes including digital literacy training
 - e. Unemployment and training through digital literacy
 - f. Effectiveness of various schemes and activities -
 - i. Panchayat, Gram Panchayat and District
 - ii. Available funds and financial resources, and the Gram Panchayat's budget
 - iii. Fairness in government
 - iv. Self-employment and group schemes
 - v. Self-employment and group
