- The time duration of the program should be minimum, preferably concluded in an hour and half beyond farming.

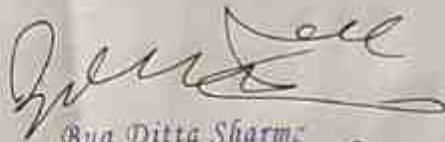
