## Special Recommendation

1. Sanitation and Cleanliness of the pvt Baidhal is the major problem. The village is ~~not~~ in unhygienic conditions.
2. The Baidhal constructed under ~~MAR~~ MANREGA is out of the reach of the people and is not been utilized. (Useless location of Baidhal)
3. The personnel services of water provided in the panchayat is underutilized and can be utilized to solve the water scarcity problem in the panchayat.
4. The Ration Distributing System (Grain Depot) is also very poor and needs to be rectified. The wheat in the Depot is not usable.
5. The Water pipes of PWE department are not in good condition, needs to be rectified. Moreover the water supply needs to be regular.
6. The Electricity supply is poor and there is shortage of poles, electricity wires are changed on the wooden poles and it is a dangerous practice.
7. The water storage tanks previously constructed under MANREGA are not being utilized properly.
8. The soak pits & Compost pits have been constructed properly, but are not utilized by the people for the purpose for which they are meant.
9. The Angan Centre, Health Centre, and Govt Higher Sec. Schools are working in a very good manner, however, the toilet work at G.H.S. Baidhal has been stopped due to negligence of Contractor (Under PAMSA).
10. The people were well aware of the major horticulture schemes, some orchards have been well established, however, the horticulture potential of panchayat is underutilized.
11. The work of Animal Husbandry Deptt. is very poor. Even the office was locked at the time of visit.
