Contractors from outside the Panchayat filed tenders at lowest rates but did not execute work in the absence 5. No compensation to the farmers for major loss in paddy crop due to distribution of poor quality of seeds. 6. Pending salary of AWWs and Midday meal cooks is the major issue. II Major/ urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: 1. Repairing of lanes and drains. 2. Removal of silt from canals and cleaning of nallahs HT and LT wire of PDD dept to be realigned. 4. Road from Sanghe Chack to Shamshan Ghat. Construction of culverts at Saharan and Bhulley Chack. Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions: III Most of the major requirements and complaints projected during the earlier three phases of Back to Village are not resolved till date. People are not satisfied with the Govt functioning. Accountability of Govt officials of the concerned Departments in the Panchayat needs to be fixed to resolve the same at the earliest.
