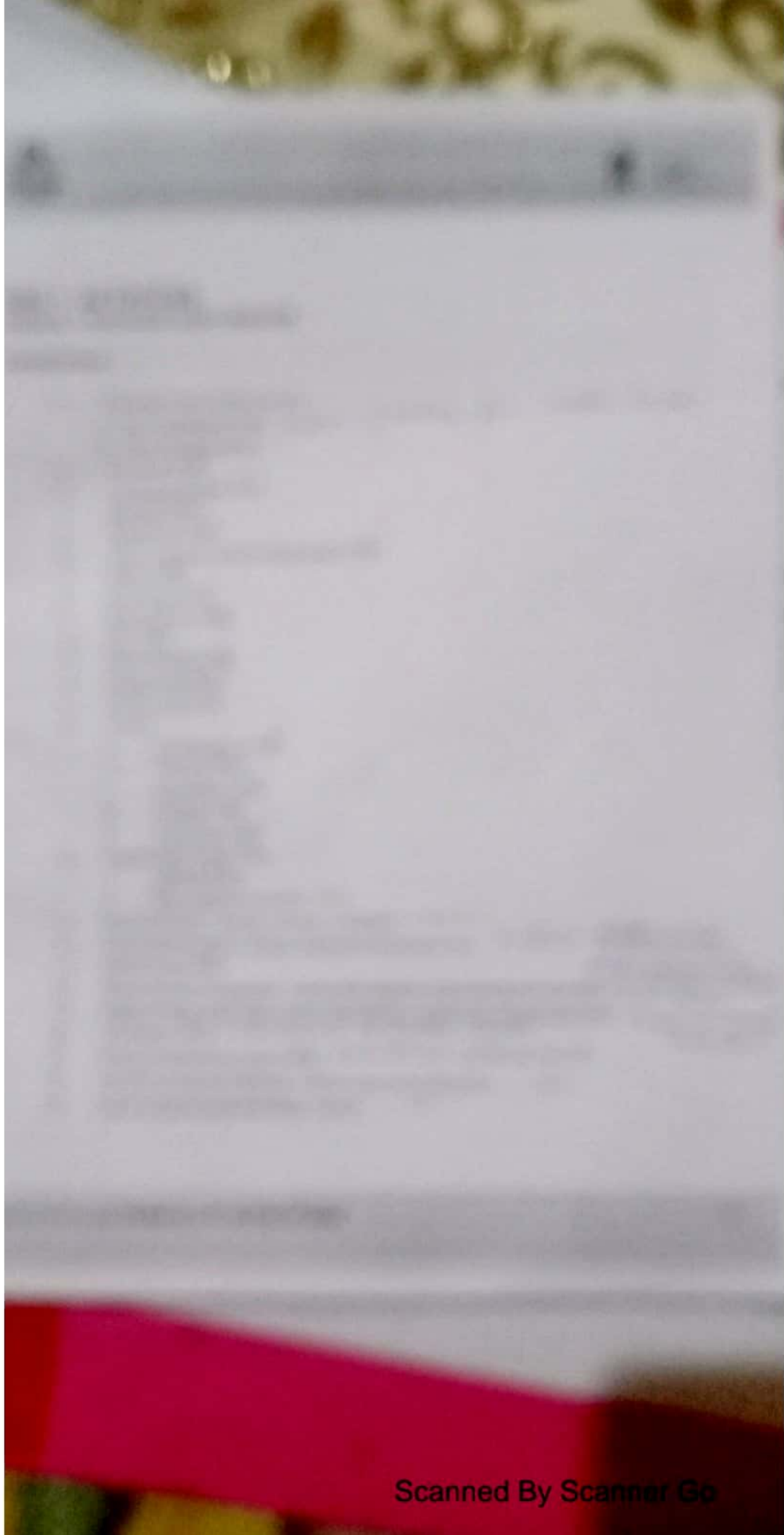

DELIVERABLES AND RECORD DEFICIENCIES IF ANY

Under Agenda 3, concerned departments put their deliberations in accordance to JAN BHIMAN. However, after taking the same in public and enquiring the record it was found:

1. That the Revenue Dept. had not issued yet any Land passport, however, official in duty claimed that out of 7632 land passports the concerned had in hand passport 7533.
2. The official of JSB Bank along with his Branch Manager provided data of KCC and it was found that out of 7000 total eligible beneficiaries only 5300 had availed the benefits of the Scheme. After from that the official made people aware of other financial schemes, like PDS etc.
3. The official from Food and Supplies Dept. also deliberated about NFSA Scheme.
4. The sports kit provided by the Panchayat has also been donated to existing Youth Club, however, members of the same club were not available on the day.
5. The Social Welfare Dept. record reflects that only 400 people are getting benefits, 0700 to widow pension, and 1300 Disability pension. It is noted to mention that the said department need to do more as many deserving people are not availing the benefits.
