



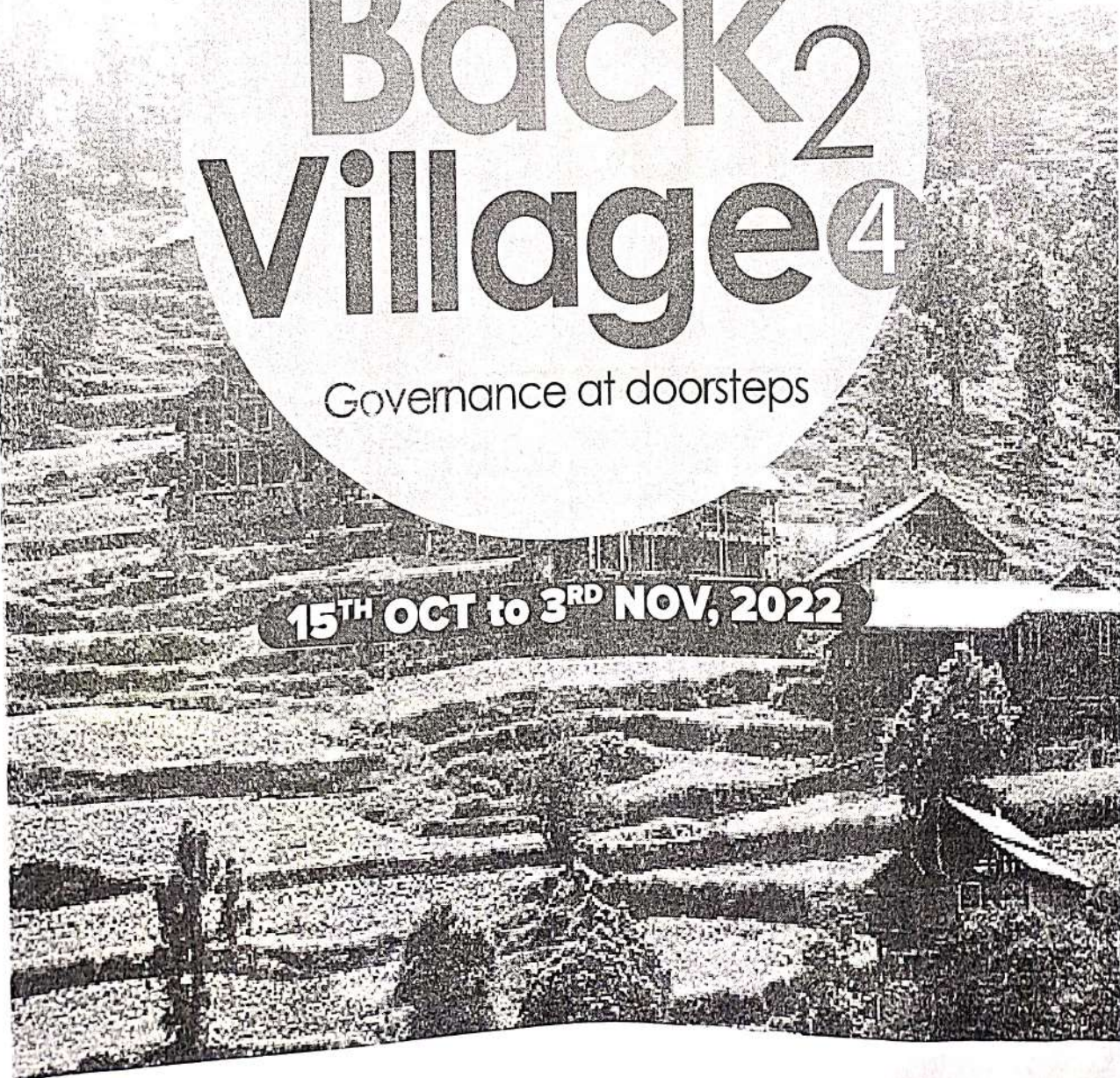

 i) Aanganwadi workers (AWC) are facing major issues with respect to  
 pay meagre pay, no job security, their linkage to almost every  
 Govt. programme but no regularity of service, no pension provision  
 and nothing at all. Very grim situation of AWC's under ICDS project.

ii) No provision of Solid Waste Management, Pourni Panchayat should  
 be brought under the provision of Municipality with proper waste  
 disposal mechanism. No consideration was given on cleanliness.

B) Major / Urgent public demands that was / were reflected earlier  
 but not addressed:-

a) Upgradation of PHC to SDH; it is one of the major issue  
 which is raised again and again but no major step have been  
 taken. This PHC caters the need of more than 1 lakh population  
 with basic facilities only and despite having nearly 24 canals  
 of land at their disposal.

C) Assessment of visit and suggestions:-

Overall the panchayat is functioning nicely but some major  
 points needs proper redressal for the holistic development:-

- 1) One route has been identified which can be developed  
 as a major trekking site for the villagers and for the tourists  
 as well (from Pourni nadah via Baba Bhawo to Bowli (Baba Nagsingh)
- 2) For a stadium amount has been sanctioned but due to some  
 religious issue, the work is at halt which needs quick start in order  
 to prevent lapse of fund.
- 3) A bus stand at the designated site needs to be developed  
 for the convenience of public.

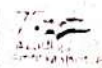
