Major Complaint


Lack of High & Higher Secondary School in Lakole Upper Panchayat. There are three middle schools and two are within a radius of 200 metres approx. There is no High School & girl students have to go either HSS Thalaval or Jommu for higher studies. Due to this drop out rate of girl students has increased in the area. Demanded for upgradation of schools from middle to High & Higher Secondary.

There is urgent public demand for construction of tube well (water source) for the over head Tank constructed at W. No 1 by the PHE department in the year 2017-18.

A tube well was sanctioned under NARSAR but has not been constructed so far.

The demand has been reflected by the public of Panchayat lakole upper in every forum but has not be addressed so far.

Overall Assessment

The Public of the Panchayat Kot upper is deprived of basic amenities like water, electricity, roads, transport, education, health, cleanliness etc. Emphasis should be laid on providing basic facilities first. The whole Panchayat must be covered under Jal Jeevan mission. Under JPM project submitted but pending for approval and sanctioning. It should be completed in a time bound manner. Condition of electric poles and wires/cables is very bad. Electric poles cables are hanging over the houses of people and there is threat to the life of people, as many incidents occurred in the past that leads to fatal casualties. PDD department must take strong note of this. There are many nallahs in the area that turned life threatening during heavy season. Flood control department must do a survey and take immediate action in this regard. ~~and take~~ on it is very surprising that there is no high & higher secondary school in the area. Demand for upgradation of middle school Kalakam and high school Kalakam was made ~~is~~ by the people since back to village one (B2V1) but no action taken  so far. Demand for Primary Health center is genuine and should be addressed in priority.
