

Sir,

We, the residents of village Logate, Tehsil & District Kathua would like to inform your good self about critical problem of water crises in Vill. Logate. The main source of water supply in **village Logate & village Sahar** is as follows:-

Source of Supply	Rate of Discharge	Village Logate	Village Sahar
Tube Well 'Logate Old'	4000 GPH	50%	50%
Tube Well 'Logate New'	2500 GPH	30%	70%
Tube Well Bhambhi	20000 GPH		50%

Above chart shows that there is no uniform pattern of water distribution despite the facts that village Logate, in terms of population and area, is greater than village Sahar.

That is why residents of village Logate (esp. ward No.1,2,3 & ward No.4) are **getting supply once in 10/12days barely for one hour**. Moreover, the water distribution system within the area of village Logate is also faulty and following are the **Core Factors** that ultimately responsible to water crisis **esp. in ward No. 1, 2, 3 & ward No.4** of village Logate:-

1. Disproportionate Water Distribution System:

For instance: i) 2" diameter pipe is laid for **03 houses** in Mohalla Raghbir Singh ii) 2" dia pipe for **4 Houses** in Mohalla Ex-Sarpanch iii) 2" dia pipe for **7 Houses** in Mohalla Serab Singh iv) 02" dia pipe for **31 houses** in mohalla Piar Singh v) 2" dia pipe for **25 Houses** from H/o Yograj Singh to H/o Mr. Sethi iii) etc etc.

In addition, Ward No.5 of village Logate is connected directly with Mains **without any control valves or suspensions**. Whenever, supply is released from **Service Reservoir**, optimum pressure does not reach the destinations and very often water trickles down the taps. It compels the demanding residents of Ward No.1, 2, 3 & 4 to purchase water at exorbitant rates (Rs.400 for 3500 ltrs.) from local tankers.

2. PHE has no Clue of Network of Pipes:

There is vast network of pipes in village Logate and PHE is totally clueless about Network of pipes. As a result, many-many individual/group of houses are getting supply directly from different Mains/Sub-Mains/Branch pipelines etc.

3. No Free Access to regulate Control Valves:

As many as **04 Control Valves** that regulates supply in different segments of ward No.1 & ward No.3, are fixed **inside the houses of PHE employees** where access is often denied by women folk, on one or the other pretext.

4. **Rampant scale illegal use of 'Utility Facility'**

There is rampant scale theft of water by tapping during late night hours. Thus, large quantity of water never reached to needy people. Such illegal activities are taking place with active connivance of PHE's Field Functionaries.

5. **Ruthless Increase in Illegal Service Connections:**

The Field Functionaries, enjoying prize posting consecutively for the last over 10/15 years do not hesitate to damage Govt. property for providing illegal connections for vested interests. Many a people are **enjoying 3 to 7 illegal service connections.**

6. **Poor performance of Field Functionaries:**

Permanent employees do not bother to deliver satisfactory services. When questioned about inordinate delay in supply, they shirk their responsibility by blaming casual staff or senior officers. In nutshell, they have nothing to do except **'Nodding Heads & Pleasing God Fathers'**.

7. **Lack of Supervision:**


No mechanism evolved to monitor day to day performance & operations carried out by the field functionary viz. Motormen, Cock Turners, Plumbing staff etc. **Hardly any record/register** is being maintained at stations. The performance of supervisory officers is also dismal. Despite repeated requests, they never bothered to interact with villagers to redress their grievances or to review the water distribution system. It reflects casual approach on the part supervisory officers.
