# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- 7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
- 8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas

## Mahila Sabha Proceedings

The Mahila Sabha was held at Panchayat Ghar on 2<sup>nd</sup> day of B2V4 programme i.e. on 1<sup>st</sup> November-2022. There is less participation and little enthusiasm among the women because their demands were hardly fulfilled during previous B2V programmes. The proceedings were recorded in the Mahila Sabha and are as hereunder:

- 1). There is scarcity of drinking water and the women folk have to travel a long distance to fetch the drinking water and therefore the issue of drinking water supply must be resolved as soon as possible by the concerned PHE Department.
- 2). There are 03 Nos. of Anganwadi centres which are unable to cater to the whole area under Panchayat Halqa. There are 7 wards in the Panchayat, therefore more AWC need to be established in order to provide the facilities to all eligible beneficiaries.
- 3). The PHC is about 2.5 Km away from the Gundi- Nowgam (Malpora) and usually remains over crowded. The women have earlier demanded that a health sub- centre be established for the Panchayat Halqa.
- 4). The old, damaged Pathwari shed in the Middlle School Gundi Nowgam poses danger to the lives of children which scare the mothers to reluctantly send their wards to school. The issue was constantly raised in previous B2V programmes and brought to the notice of all concerned authorities but till date nothing concrete was done. The damaged shed/structure must be dismantled as early as possible to avoid any untoward incident.
- 5). There is rise in female-teasing, alcoholism and drug menace which must be tackled by the concerned police station and administration should take steps to eradicate this menace. The police station in particular should constitute a team for random checks in the area and punish the culprits sternly. The concerned SHO should also provide his phone number to the public to receive the information once the culprits are identified by any individual but SHO should not disclose the name of the person who makes a complaint due to possible fear of reprisal by the culprits/gangs.
  - 6). There are no Government sweepers in the Panchayat Halqa for the disposal of solid waste which usually pollutes the area where solid waste is disposed. Therefore there is need of sweepers in the area who will be enrolled in Muncipilaty/ concerned department.

- 7). There is no Community Hall in the Panchayat Halqa and thus there is a need to construct one in the area which will be used for marriage functions, social support and to gather people for group activities and other purposes.
- 8). The source of drinking water i.e. River Jehlum and Ferozpur Channel is polluted and rife with animal carcasses which has now resulted in many water borne diseases among children and old persons besides young ones. The administration should direct the municipality or concerned department to take out the rotten carcasses and bury/burn these as is feasible to prevent the spread of water borne diseases. Pertinently the persons involved in disposing the dead animals in any water body should be punished under LAW.
- 9). The drinking water supply is erratic and interrupted which severely effects the day to day activity of the villagers. In order to mitigate this problem, the administration must direct the concerned department to dig some Ground water bore wells and Over Head Tank (OHT) should also be constructed to mitigate the suffering of the people and to avoid the long distance travels by the women folk to fetch water.

### Bal Sabha Proceedings

The Bal Sabha was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> day of B2V4 programme i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> November-2022 at Panchayat Ghar. The students from different schools in the Panchyat Halqa participated. The students were feeling dejected and pessimistic about the B2V programmes as most of their demands raised during the previous B2V programmes were still pending. The students mocked that the Government/ Revenue department could not even dismantle the dilapidated Pathwari shed lying in the school for so many years which was found to be true. The recorded proceedings in the Bal Sabha are as under:

- 1). There is an old, dilapidated, flood damaged Pathwari shed/structure in the yard of Middle School Gundi-Nowgam. The structure is damaged to such an extent that it may collapse at any time and GOD FORBID, may result in the grave tragedy or even loss of life as small children roam in and around the shed. The authorities are well aware of the fact but have not taken any concrete action on the ground so far. The shed must be dismantled as soon as possible to avoid any untoward incident due to its collapse.
- 2). The schools in the Panchayat Halqa have less space/rooms due to which these cannot cater to the increasing rate of admission. The school buildings therefore must have another storey to accommodate the students. The Middle School Junction Mohalla Gundi-Nowgam has no fencing which results in frequent damages and theft attempts. This school should be safeguarded by constructing the concrete compound wall around the school premises.
- 3). The sports paraphernalia in the schools is less than what is actually required and this leads to less participation of students in sports activity at schools. So in order to resolve this problem, the schools must be provided with the necessary sports kits for maximum participation by students of every class.
- 4). The Middle Schools in the Panchayat Halqa must be provided with modern day tools/equipments and gadgets for labs to properly demonstrate the experiments and updated liberties which serve as a storehouse of information and reading platform.
- 5). The students have repeatedly demanded the development of Park and stadium/play ground for sports activities. There is a vast land available (which is more than 600 kanals as per Sarpanch and local residents) in the Panchayat Halqa but till date only DPR has been framed by R&B department for the stadium without any ground work.
- 6). The Police must take strict action against drug peddlers/addicts, drunkards and female-teasers who now pose a threat to the society. The Police must pay surprise visits frequently and take action against the culprits.

- 7). There are no computer teachers in the schools in Gundi-Nowgam which leads to inadequacy in computer skills among the students. This is also the long pending demand of students so it must be addresses by the district administration to solve this grievance.
- 8). There are no female teachers/staff available in the schools in Gundi -Nowgam and female students in particular want that a female teacher/s be deputed to these schools to overcome their shyness in seeking answers to queries related to certain subjects.
- 9). The students want that more toilets/wash rooms be constructed in the schools to cater to the needs of the students and that the damaged walls/ plumbing damages / broken items in the already existing toilets be repaired.
- 10). The students demand that the schools be upgraded to High school level particularly Govt. Middle School Gundi-Nowgam keeping in view the increase in admissions and shortage of staff in far away High school. This will increase the efficiency of the staff and simultaneously improve the performance of the students by continuing their education in the same school.

## Major complaints brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer

- 1). The front line workers of the social welfare department are delinquent as per the Panchayat members which was also found true while I repeatedly rang them but there was no response for two days from their end. The front line workers of the social welfare department didn't bother to turn up at the Panchayat Halqa for the whole B2V4 programme. The record pertaining to the department was acquired through frontline workers of ICDS. There is also severe allegation from the Panchayat members and other locals of the Panchayat Halqa against the department personnel for taking bribe before handing over the special schemes/assistance to beneficiaries like marriage assistance scheme, old age pension, etc. Therefore the matter is grave and needs to be investigated further in order to punish the violators/culprits under LAW.
- 2). The Rural Development Department has not resolved the complaints related to PMAY which has led to non disbursement of money/benefits under the scheme to eligible beneficiaries until now. The GP has repeatedly requested the RDD and even submitted the resolution to that effect but unfortunately nothing concrete has been done so far. Therefore the matter must be resolved as soon as possible to allow the eligible beneficiaries to avail the benefits under the scheme.
- 3). There is an old, completely damaged, flood damaged Pathwari shed/structure structure in the yard of Middle School Gundi-Nowgam. The structure is damaged to such an extent that it may collapse at any time and GOD FORBID, may result in the grave tragedy or even loss of life as small children roam in and around the shed. The concerned authorities are well aware of the fact but have not taken any concrete action on the ground so far. The shed must be dismantled as soon as possible to avoid any untoward incident due to its collapse.
- 4). The Wasikhan Lift Irrigation Scheme had been conceived probably under TAC-8 i.e. in the year 2008 scheme but till date the Civil Irrigation Department Sumbal is not able to construct the concrete structure for the scheme despite the availability of funds. The non execution of the scheme has led to severe damage to livelihood of majority of poor farmers who are solely dependent on agriculture crops/produce.
- 5). The irrigation canals/pump stations for their agriculture lands have not been de-silted and repaired by Civil Irrigation Division Sumbal which hinders/interrupts the movement of water to each field in time. The Civil Irrigation Division Sumbal be directed to repair the damages to the irrigation pump stations and more importantly de-silt the canals properly to allow uninterrupted supply of water to agriculture fields.
- 6). The contractors who have executed the PRI works i.e. up-gradation of inner road links have only been given CC-1st part of payment but not the CC final payment which led to the lapse of funds previous year. The issue must be resolved to utilize the funds allotted for the works.

## Major/urgent public demands that were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far

- 1). The residents of the Gundi-Nowgam area demand that their village should be declared as Backward.
- 2). The area urgently requires drinking water facility to every household and the water supply scheme is approved under JJM. The residents demand that the work on the schemes shall start quickly without any bottle necks so that it gets completed without any delay.
- 3). The villagers on the whole i.e. of Gundi-Nowgam and adjoining areas demand that the Wasikhan Lift Irrigation Scheme be constructed as early as possible to save their livelihood which is mostly dependent on agriculture and be a source for the up-liftment of the area also.
- 4). There is a major demand for construction of Community Hall in the area to cater to different occasions like marriage functions, social gatherings etc.
- 5). The residents particularly young demand that the work on the Stadium/play field should start as the DPR for the same has been submitted by R&B department but no progress has been made by the concerned department till date.
- 6). The villagers demand that a health sub-centre be established in the Panchayat Halqa as the PHC which is about 2.5 km away usually remains over crowded.
- 7). The students of the area demand that a Primary and High school be provided in the area. The alternative to that is the up-gradation of Middle School Gundi-Nowgam in particular or Middle School Malpora to High School keeping in view the increase in admissions and shortage of staff in far away High schools. This will increase the efficiency of the staff and simultaneously improve the performance of the students by continuing their education in the same school.
- 8). There are 07 wards in the Panchayat Halqa and only 03 Anganwadi centres which cannot cater to the whole area. So the residents demand that more AWCs be established so that the people can avail benefits.
- 9). The residents demand that OHT be constructed in the Panchayat Halqa to mitigate the interrupted supply of drinking water to households.
- 10). The residents demand that few more HT Transformers be installed in the area to meet the increasing demand of electricity and overcome the low voltage problem to far away households.
- 11). The Panchayat demands that a J&K Bank branch with ATM be provided in the area so that people can avail the bank facilities easily.

## Overall Assessment of the Visiting Officer

The residents of the Gundi-Nowgam Panchayat are more pessimistic, hopeless and disappointed about functioning of the Panchayat in general and the B2V programmes in particular due to the reason that most of their demands/requirements have not been fulfilled. The residents allege that none of their problems have been redressed so far. The people allege that the Panchayat has not done anything more appreciable than what used to be done by the departments before the inception of Panchayat body. The people allege that the members of all Panchayats in general have in one way or the other taken undue benefits. The residents claim that nothing has changed since B2V1 programme because they have been reporting the same set of demands/problems in each programme which are still unresolved. This has led to negative impression and perception towards the functioning of the Government as whole. It took the undersigned a lot of time to pacify the disgruntled villagers during my visit so as to commence the programme. The main important issues which need to be addressed so as to win the people's hearts again are hereunder:

- 1). The completely damaged Pathwari shed inside the campus of Middle School Gundi-Nowgam must be dismantled before the collapse of the shed on its own which may lead to major tragedy or even loss of life, GOD FORBID.
- 2). The scarcity of drinking water in the village results in two-three trips of long distance travels by female fork to fetch potable water. This problem must be resolved as early as possible by directing the PHE department to carry out the necessary works in resolving the potable water scarcity on war footing basis under JJM scheme.
- 3). The Wasikhan Lift Irrigation Scheme was conceived probably under TAC-8 i.e. in the year 2008 but till date the Civil Irrigation Department is not able to construct the concrete structure for the scheme despite the availability of funds. The Mechanical Irrigation Division has then timely procured all the machinery/equipments required for the operation of the scheme but due to non availability of structure by Civil Irrigation Division, the machinery is lying unutilized. The non execution of the scheme has led to severe damage to livelihood of majority of poor farmers who are solely dependent on agriculture crops/produce. The Civil Irrigation Division be directed to complete the construction of the structure.
- 4). The schools in the Panchayat Halqa should to have at least second storey to accommodate the new students and optimum space for already existing students. The Middle School Junction Mohalla Gundi-Nowgam should be safeguarded by constructing the concrete compound wall/fencing around the school premises.

- 5). In order to make each student in the schools to participate in the sports activities, adequate number of sports kits should be available in the schools. The library and labs in the schools should be upgraded. The labs should be equipped with the modern day tools/equipments and gadgets to properly demonstrate the experiments.
- 6). The village has no playground for sports activity but there is a vast land available about 600 kanals as per the Panchayat which must be developed for stadium, village HAAT, Circus/Fun Fair ground and for recreational activity, etc.
- 7). The cases of female teasing, alcoholism and drug addicts are on the rise which must be tackled by the administration and more particularly by concerned Police Station with stringent punishment to culprits. The police should organise programmes/camps and help locals who otherwise have a fear of reprisal by reporting the culprits to police.
- 8). The Middle Schools in the village should have female teachers for mental, emotional and educational needs of female students and to make a gender balance and there should be computer teachers in schools to teach the computer skills to students.
- 9). At least one Middle School in the village must be upgraded to High school level in first phase keeping in view the increase in admissions and shortage of staff in far away High school. This will increase the efficiency of the staff and simultaneously improve the performance of the students by continuing their education in the same school.
- 10). The 03 Anganwadi centres presently in the Panchayat Halqa need to be upgraded with heating facility during the winters to work more effectively. In order to provide the facilities to all eligible beneficiaries of the 07 wards in the Panchayat Halqa, more AWC need to be established. The Anganwadi workers should be provided the monthly honorarium regularly so that the work culture can be improved in AWCs.
- 11). The Community Hall should be constructed for the villagers to meet their different purposes like marriage functions, social gatherings etc.
- 12). The administration should devise a plan to clean and dispose the solid waste by employing the sweepers. The solid waste segregation is required to prepare the compost etc.
- 13). There is a demand from the residents that a Health sub-centre should be established in the Panchayat Halqa to provide the primary health care services like medical treatment, immunization, awareness programmes about health and nutrition, etc.

- 14) To counter the low voltage problem to far end users and frequent damage to HT Transformer/s particularly during winter season, more HT Transformers are needed to distribute the electric load properly among the households.
- 15). The Panchayat demands that a J&K Bank branch with ATM be provided in the area so that the residents can avail the bank facilities with ease.
- 16). The irrigation canals/pump stations which supply water to their agriculture lands have not been de-silted and repaired by Civil Irrigation Division Sumbal and it results in damage to pumps and interruption in water supply to each field in time. The Civil Irrigation Division Sumbal be directed to repair the damages to the irrigation pump stations and de-silt the canals properly to allow uninterrupted supply of water to agriculture fields.
- 17). The source of drinking water i.e. River Jehlum and Ferozpur Channel is polluted and rife with animal carcasses which has now resulted in many water borne diseases among children and old persons besides young ones. The administration should direct the municipality or concerned department to take out the rotten carcasses and bury/burn these as is feasible to prevent the spread of water borne diseases. Pertinently the persons involved in disposing the dead animals in any water body should be punished under LAW.
