7. Many major deliverable department offices are far away from the panchayat that needs to be addressed earliest.
8. Project in JJM schme of Jal shakti Department (Taryoli Lift Scheme for Salanger) Delayed inPanchayat Salyoteue to not receiving NOC from Forest Department
9. Project in Jal shakti Department
10. Amrit Sarovar of Slanger.

II. Major/Urgent public demands that were reflected earliest but have not been addressed:

1. Road connectivity and water supply to every household.
2. Establishment of Health Sub-centre /Animal Health centre in panchayat.
3. No playground/ Children park.
4. Vocational Training Centre.

III. Overall Assessment:

As panchayat Salyote fall in the last boundary between district Jammu and district Rajouri. Salyote panchayat is having 07 wards out of which ward no. 1,2&3 fall in the hilly terrain while remaining wards terrain is plain. My suggestions are:

1. This panchayat needs to be included in the district Rajouri so that major departmental schemes shall reach in the panchayat easily, effectively and smoothly.
2. Lots of work needs to be done at ground level for that more department official needed and people awareness much needed.
3. Drinking water facilities/ Irrigation water facilities must be given to the panchayat inhabitants.
4. Road connectivity required for development.
5. Playground/Sports facilities needs to be improved.
6. Skill training centre/Vocational/Handicrafts/Handloom required in the panchayat Salyote.
