GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER① Major Complaints brought to the Notice of the visiting Officer1. Road connectivity from N.H. Nournath to village Kanah (8 km)

During my visit to village Kanah, general masses of the area very angrily / bitterly projected the complaint against the officers/public representatives for befooling us by putting shadows on our eyes that your road project has been kept in plan for early start up since independence. We are being used for electoral purposes only and made promises by the public representatives especially during election time and also in the earlier three back to village programmes we have projected it but nothing has been appeared so far. Other women, school going children are facing lot of hardships, Majority of the children deprived of Education due to road connectivity, especially girls children because they have to travel atleast 16 km (updown) by foot through nallah (khad) to approach H-way to catch bus after their ^{pre}schooling. Some Pregnant women leads to death during delivery due to road connectivity lacked.

2. PHE : A PHE tank completed in the year 2014 at w. No. 2 but till date it is not made functional for water supply. Also no regular salary for daily wages.

3. Electricity : About (70 - 80) % of the electric wire has loosened/ damaged but no hearing of the public after repeated complaints through Public representatives also.

4. Complain of Village Salori and its surroundings w. No. 1 that besides repeated assurances of P.W.D. deptt. our road work is not being started in which tendering of the work has also been done.

5. Wild life Animals :- A complain against wild life animals is being projected by the general masses that our crops are being fully destroyed by the wild animals, like monkeys, pigs etc. So the concerned deptt. should be put into action because majority of public are having agriculture is the only source of their living. Due to which the farmers also abide farming.

6. No X-Ray technician, no ultra sound machine in the hospital

7. Liability of MGNREGA for the year 2016-17, and (2017-18) are not being cleared.

1. Burning demand of Road from N.H. NouNath to Village Kanah, Basawa and its adjoining villages length about 8 kms.
