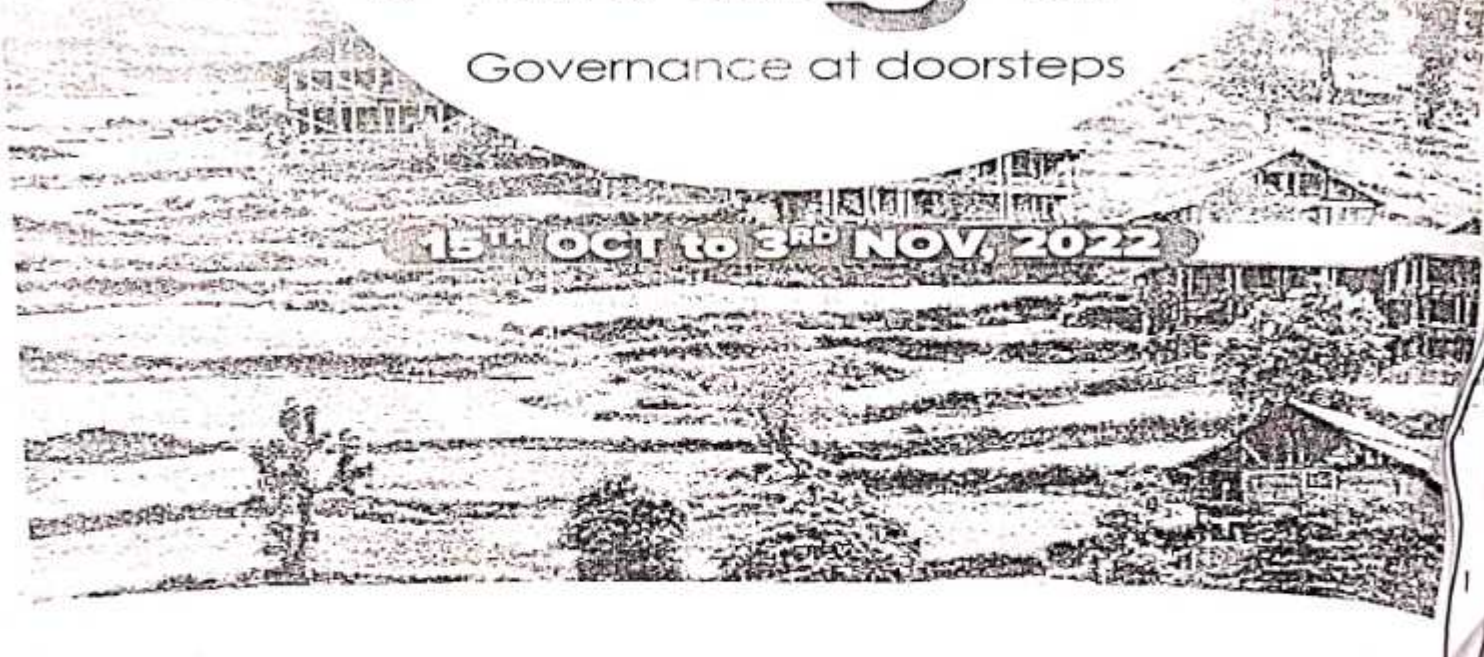

1. The grass roots democracy is functioning quite well.
2. Govt offices and officials are responsive.
3. However the lack of science teachers is a very serious issue.
4. The Hr. Sec. School lacks a full-time principal with ddo powers which affects the functioning of the school and execution of local fund activities.
5. The school's sanitation facilities are dismal
6. Students trudge long distances in the absence of transport facilities.
7. For such a large area there is no allopathic doctor.
8. The road to the govt offices area needs upgradation and black topping.
9. Electric transformers need protection and there were complaints that conductors are still hung on trees.
10. A reasi to arnas ramban tourist circuit can be developed.
11. Women entrepreneurs need more motivation and access to markets.
12. the populace requires broadband and fiber connectivity.
13. Playing field on banks of the Ans nallah needs to be developed.
14. Mining activities have shifted the course of the Ans nallah towards the town which requires control.
15. Due to lack of a few poles houses in ward no. 6 (Dughdhaar) remain unelectrified.
16. SEVERE MONKEY MENACE
17. MGNREGA payments are pending since 2016.
18. There is significant delay in clearing of pendency in the treasury.
19. A munsiff court can be established in the Tehsil.
20. The Panchayat lost significant lands to the SALAL project but the NHPC has not been involved in any significant CSR activities.


