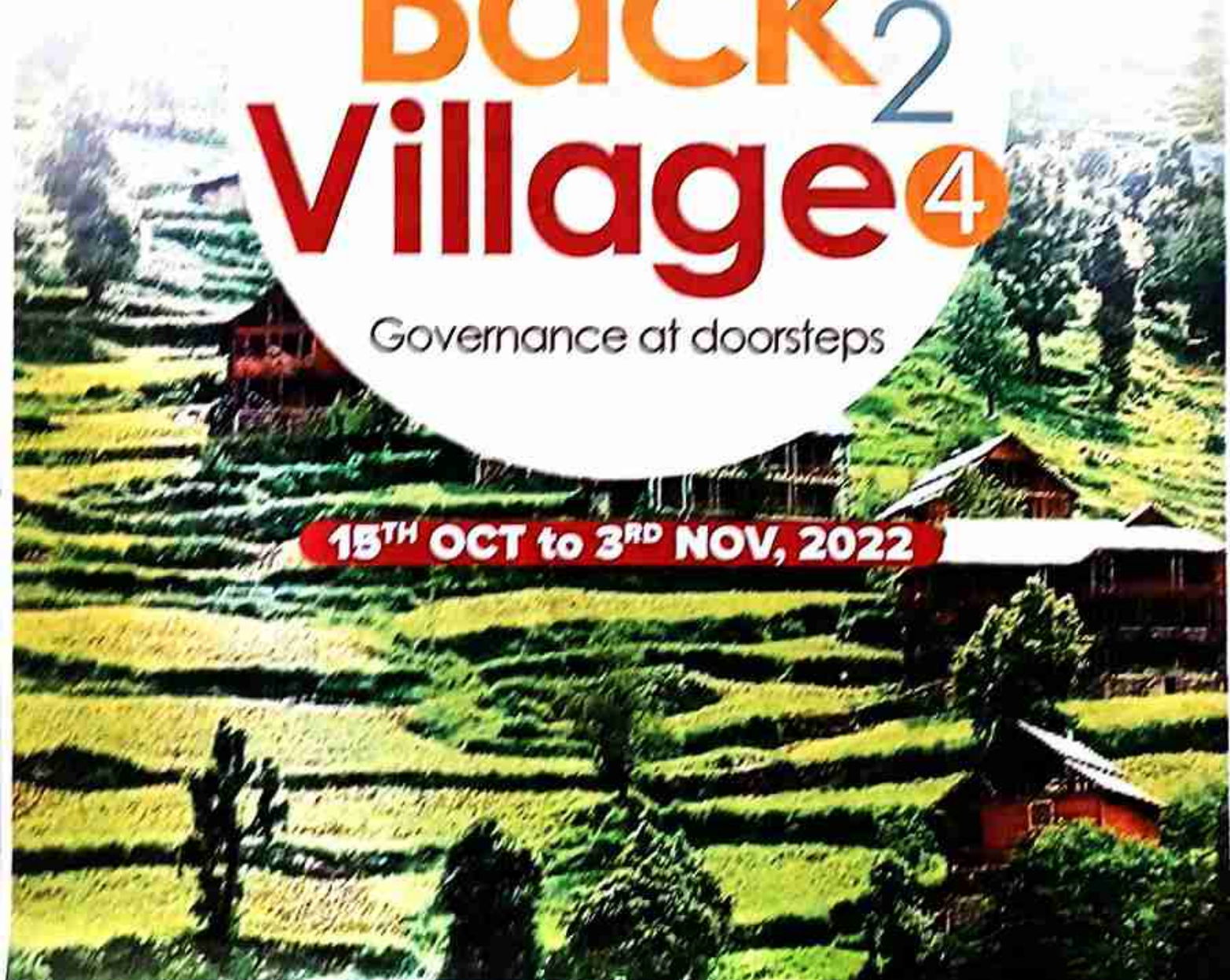

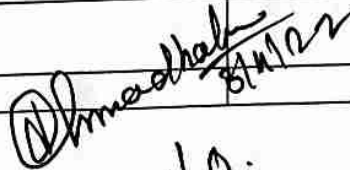

Sir,

With humble submission and high regards I want to state that this institution is functioning from classes 6th to 10th having a Roll of 220 students. The Institution is facing below mentioned problems.

1. The institution has dearth of staff having only 08 teachers/Masters for 220 students. Classes 9th and 10th have two sections each. Needless to mention here that no junior Assistant is working in the institution and one teacher has to carry out the official Assignments also. It is as such requested to kindly direct the concerned Authorities to provide requisite staff for the institution.
2. The institution is without fencing, main gate and chowkidar, as a result of which school buildings very often get damaged after school hours. As such it is requested to do the needful on priority basis.
3. The institution is getting water supply through a temporary plastic pipeline from the source. But frequently we face shortage of water as the said plastic pipeline is of temporary nature and gets damaged very often due to its fragile nature. As such it is requested to your goodself that necessary instructions may kindly be given to concerned Authorities to provide new pipeline for the institution. Few pipes provided for the purpose are insufficient.
4. The institution has shortage of washrooms having only (02) washrooms for 220 students (both male and female) and 8 staff members. As such it is requested to kindly take up the issue with the concerned department so that more washrooms may be constructed at an earliest.

Keeping in view the above facts, it is requested to your goodself that the above mentioned grievances may kindly be redressed at an earliest.

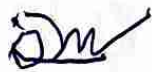

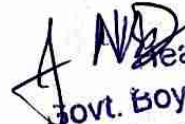

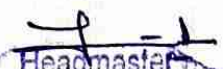
