General Assessment, Urgent and Long term problem

- To start with, the Panchayat is diagnosed with chronic non-trickle down of welfare schemes.
- B2V1, B2V2, B2V3 have not been implemented; Very less participation was observed in B2V4 (people (Gram Sabha) complained of cosmetic promises and loss of visiting officers).
 - Black topping and Repairing of Roads is required.
 - Transformers of PDD dept needs upgradation. Electric poles and wiring needs to be corrected urgently. (W.M.S.)
 - Jtk Bank is urgently required at land identified in Bathess.
 - ATMs of Jtk Bank and Hdfc Bank is required.
