Sir,

With reference to the above cited communication on the subject wherein the DEMAND was "providing of pump shed to Kensu for irrigating of orchards" & the DIRECTION was "to examine the need for providing of pump shed for purpose".

After examining the demand, it is felt necessary to clarify here that it is not feasible to lift water from Zaingeer canal for irrigating the orchards because of following facts that:-

1. The Zaingeer Canal has lost its carrying capacity due to huge siltation all along its length which has not been cleared for a long time till date.
2. The benefecries of tail end of zaingeer canal (which falls in sopore constituency) face scarcity of irrigation supplies in general. To over come this shortfall, a drought pump had been installed at Watlab with source as Walur lake which is just 1½ Km D/S of Kensu & is de-funct at present & needs to be re-activated for which provision has been kept in the comprehension DPR of Zaingeer canal already submitted to Govt, but not funded as yet. To provide a lift scheme at Kensu & having a drought pump just 1½ km D/s of this spot is a contradiction to the system & does not seem justified. This will definently result in further shortfall to the tail ends of Zaingeer canal which will crate law and order problem in the area.

It is felt that, to boost the people of one area at the cost of other area seems unjustified & is not feasible when the tail area of Zaingeer Canal is already facing irrigation crises during peak irrigation season.

We take this opportunity to solicit your kind attention towards the following facts:

We the villagers of Kehnusa, Tehsil Aloosa, District Bandipora are living in extreme difficult times as our only livelihood source i.e. our orchards are at the verge of extinction facing draught like situation due to the abnormal weather conditions from last many years.

Since the frequency and quantity of rainfall at regular intervals round the year in general and during seasonal period in particular has been badly affected, the village orchards have been severely damaged and if needful is not done in time, we fear of losing them altogether in near future.

Ninety percent (90%) population of our village is directly dependent on agricultural activities and the given orchards play an important role in the economy of entire village. But due to the shortage of regular rainfall and absence of proper irrigation mechanism, we are at the verge of losing this economic source of our village for ever.


Our village is blessed with many water bodies such as Nahr-e-Zainageer, Wular Lake and Nullah which run parallel to our agricultural and orchard lands. But due to the lack of attention on part of our district administration we are still devoid of any such measure to harness the same.

We have multiple times approached the concerned authorities before regarding installation or irrigation lifting pump to harness irrigation supply to our orchards, and we are still running from pillar to post to put across our message cum complaint, but although promised many times, nothing was done on land.

Now we the poor villagers see a ray of hope in your excellency and we are hopeful that your excellency would look into the matter so that our only source of income and livelihood is saved for once and all.
