(Annexure P') Overall Assessment of the visit & suggestions

During the visit in B2V4 programme on 2-11-2022 & 3-11-2022 following observations were made by me in the panchayat.

- ① Panchayat lacks basic infrastructure like khindal centre/any other banking facility, no ration depot (priv/govt in the panchayat).
- ② Moreover, departments are running from rented buildings which require renovation (like Health & Wellness subcentres).
- ③ Students are deprived of playground facility.
- ④ Active participation of the PRIs (as perpanch & panchayat) and local people is hugely required for the overall development of the panchayat.
- ⑤ Departments are working satisfactorily but still scope of improvement in the working.

Suggestion :- while preparation of the plans for execution in coming/next financial year, PRIs of concerned panchayat must be consulted & their requirements be addressed by all the govt. departments including RDD, PHE, PDD, PWD etc. Camps must be frequently conducted by departments like Revenue, Agriculture, Health, Banking etc. Also the works proposed under "Back to village programme" must be given priority & necessary funds should be released to the govt. departments for their execution as most of the departments are working under CSC not under Back to village head:

Requirements Raised in B2V4 programme:-

- 1) Road Connectivity:-
- I) Road from Palli to upper Haryan
 - II) Road from Dehal to Bakkal. (already DPR)
 - III) Road from Saneot to Kheri prepared under PWD.
 - IV) PWD road from Railway bridge no. 17A Palli to Govt. Middle School Khurdian Neela (Haryan).
 - V) Urgent requirement of footbridge in WNo-5 under PWD.
 - VI) PWD roads need repair & maintenance as it has developed few accidental spots.
- 2) Jal Shakti:-
- I) JJM scheme has been delayed.
 - II) Technical staff not available in the panchayat.
 - III) Water supplied in Mohalla Jamwal is not fit for drinking.

- 2) Irrigation & flood control :- I) Construction of khell in Mahalla Jarnal is left unattended from last to last year.
 II) Requirement of created wall to protect fields adjacent to the local mallahs.
- 4) Power Development :- I) low capacity transformers to be upgraded. in W-2, 6, 8
 II) Requirement of electric poles in few wards.
 III) Electric balls are not as per meter reading.
 IV) Technical staff not attending the panchayat.
- 5) Education :- I) Shortage of teaching & non-teaching staff.
 II) Most of schools have no boundary walls which needs to be constructed immediately.
 III) Requirement of play ground & children park.
- 6) Health & Medical education :-
 I) Subcentre to be upgraded to Primary Health centre & doctor post to be created.
 II) Rented building is very bad condition, requires immediate renovation especially to roof.
- 7) Revenue department :- Settlement of Pyt is still pending and hence land pass books not issued till date.
- 8) ICDS :- I) Requirement of building.
 II) Salaries to be released on monthly basis & and shall also be increased to a certain extent.

- 1) Other demands :-
 I) One Khinal centre
 II) one Ration depot.
 III) Ponds in W.N.D:-2
 IV) Labour rates to be revised under MGNREGA.
 V) Solar lights to be provided in the panchayat.

Respectfully we submit that the following quite genuine demands which were included in B2-V1 to V3 remained un-attended ~~as~~ upto this stage:-

(a) B2, V1 demands:

1. Completion of PWD road from Bari to Upper Hartaryan.
2. Construction of PWD road from Dhalal to Bakal Hartaryan.

(b) B2-V2 demands:

1. New PMGSY road from Sonot to Kund Hartaryan via Jamwal/Pagwal. ^{w-3}
2. Settlement of village Hartaryan. (Revenue department)
Settlement of Pyt Hartaryan is still pending and as such pass books to farmers not issued.

(c) B2-V3 demands:

1. Irrigation department - Under PMKSY a canal is under construction from Hartaryan top to Mohalla Jamwal which is still lying un-attended. No work was done during last year and this year is also over. Work remained as un-attended.
2. shifting of BO Hartaryan under Supdt of Post offices Udhampur. As BO approved for village Hartaryan is now-a-days is located at village Sonari which is to be shifted near Pyt Ghar-Hartaryan in order to meet the requirement of Pyt Hartaryan. A new BO be allowed for Sonari if demanded.

2. In addition to above, the following genuine demands may very kindly be considered during B2-V4:-

(a) ~~Water department~~ Water being supplied in mohalla Jamwal is ~~not~~ fit for drinking. Water in all other locations is still to be tested.

A new ~~water~~ reservoir near Kalka Mata is available and the same may be extended to entire Upper Hartaryan after water testing in order to meet the requirement.

- (b) Electric department. A new transformer to be provided to Govt PHC Hartaryan for which DPR for Rs 11.66 lacs stands sent to Distt offices/chairman DDC Udhampur but the case remained un-attended. since PHC is working 24 x 7 basis for a number of villages which is not to be delayed.
- A new transformer for mohalla Jamwal is pending with the department for the last so many years. It was included in Back to village programme as confirmed by electric office Udhampur under his NO M&Ry/Udh/3137-38 of 30-8-2019.
- Electric meters. electric meters stand provided to sagalta and Bakal areas whereas entire Upper Hartaryan area is still to covered. some persons have arranged the meters at their own and the amount paid by them is to be refunded.
- (c) KVK in Distt: Udhampur. DC Udhampur has not yet taken any action on Tehsildar Udhampur NO TUDR/OO/2020-21/343 354 of 6-8-2020.
- (d) sports. Play ground in vill Hartaryan. As per sports council NO SC/Works/3629-vi/576-77 of 28-1-22 state land is to be identified before 10-02-2022 which is kept pending in the office of Teh Udhampur as per AC (Rev) Udhampur NO ACRU/SQ/598-603 of 26-5-2022.
- (e) Peace Committee. As Pyt Adalat is not approved as per Director Rural Dev Jammu NO DRDJ/RTI-Appn/2021-22/12/22066-67 of 27-10-21, we suggested to approve a peace committee to be approved by the AC (Dev) or BDO concerned so that court/Police cases are avoided. This remained un-attended.
- (f) Improvement of Pyt Ghar. electric & water supply connection is still to be done. A post of Mali/Peon or chowkidar is to be created. The complaint box kept at Pyt Ghar is not made function as not even a single complaint is made known to the applicant. No resolution is approved in any meeting in the past relating to all other departments (except block agency). Therefore working of Secretary Pyt needs to be improved. Ward Majlis not created.
- (g) Grievances. At Distt: level, action as per Govt order NO 1361-GAD of 2018 is to be taken regularly. Grievances submitted on Wednesday did not bring any result. We hope your goodself will be kind enough to kindly include our above letter with your inspection report to be sent to District office.
