= Under B2A below mentioned demands be redressed Early so that Back to village programme in Phanchayat Halga would be taken successfully.

- (1) Drinking water facility to be provided in all Phanchayat Halga as it is the dire need of public.
- (2) Construction of Bridge ^{at} Wani Mohla Munda, as it is the hurdle of whole locality. Just here more bridges on the irrigation canals near Gms. Munda and K.G.B. must be taken up at an early.
- (3) Provision of water facility to K.G.B.
- (4) Provision of Electric poles & water facility to Gulshan Colony Munda near Chetkale Road.
- (5) Leakage of Zamjair Canal at Paleya Khan Munda.
- (6) Construction of new building for Phe Munda as the land is available in Munda. The Phe at this time is in a rent building which is quite unsafe and un-hygienic.

- ⑦ Construction of well which is already in chafazard planer, may be Constructed on concrete bases as it is the main source of drinking water facility to Mundri.
- ⑧ Provision of playground at Mundri.
- ⑨ Upgradation of tile path from main gate to GMS & BMS Mundri School.
- ⑩ The Reenumeration of Asha workers, social welfare workers etc may please be Enhanced.
- ⑪ PMAY Cases Should be Enhanced yearly as there are more than 20 cases which are deserving for financial help.
