





Overall Assessment

Panchayat Bhattian (Block Plangarh)

The visit to the panchayat was quite satisfactory, people of the area extended cooperation during the entire period of visit. The overall perception of people regarding functioning of government at Panchayat level is good. However, there are certain critical issues frequently brought to the notice of the visiting officer and requiring immediate redress:

1. **Bifurcation of the Panchayat into Upper Bhattian and Lower Bhattian** as Panchayat Bhattian has population of 3252(approx) and 760 households extending to a larger area.
2. **Youth Inspiration Award** to Aqib Aziz Mirza S/o Abdul Aziz Mirza, a youngster for starting **Al-Shore Dairy** in Bhattian and generating employment to 7-8 workers.
3. **Tourism Reception Centre or Tourism Huts** with Viewpoints at **Peer Klewa** which gives a scenic view from the top of ridge. Development of **Ziarat Shareef complex** to attract tourists.
4. Scarcity of water in general and drinking water in particular in ward no 01,02, 03 and 09.(no pipeline connections- 4" 500 metres pipeline required)
5. No road connectivity in ward no 01 and 09 which makes it difficult for the inhabitants to commute on daily basis.
6. Encroachment of Govt. Middle School, Hasyote land due to non availability of boundary wall and upgradation of the school to High School.
7. Non availability of School building and infrastructure for Govt. Primary School, Peer Qalewa in ward no 9 and no pacca rooftop in school building of Govt. Primary School Rakh Naliyan in ward no 3, acute shortage of Drinking water in Govt. Girls Middle School, Bhattian Wno.3 and Govt. Primary School, Upper Bhattian.
8. Non availability of toilet complex, sufficient rooms, boundary wall and sufficient First Aid medicines in the **Incharge Subcentre, Bhattian**. Moreover it should be upgraded to **Medical Aid Centre** to address immediate health emergencies of its residents.

In addition, the following demands were made by general public:

1. Tile work on path from main road to Ziarat Sharief, and Handpump near Ziarat Baba Sain Walidad, Bhattian.
2. Repair of main road having potholes.
3. Black top road under PMGSY from main road to Ward 9 Ziarat Peer Qalewa.(5kms approx)
4. 100-150 Solar Lights for Panchayat Bhattian.
5. Repair of water leakage(5000gallons a day) in Water supply(Dugwell) w no 5, building of rooftop to prevent contamination of water and Stabilizer for Dugwell in Panchayat Bhattian.
6. 150 Poles (electricity)for all wards and
7. H/TANK NHO Sikander Khan in Wno.5.
8. Load Imbalance and greater Span in Phases Conductor Wire-5000metres and 18 transformers(per ward 2)
9. B/path to Masjid from Dar Mohalla w. no 8 NHO Shabir Ahmed.
10. Handpump in Wno 3 mohalla Gai Dhara Mohra

11. Boundary Wall around Masjid in Wno 7 near Panchayat Ghar Bhattian.
12. Building for AWCs
13. Handpump at GMS Bhattian wno 3


