OVERALL ASSESMENT OF VISIT AND SUGGESTIONS

As part of the Back to Village phase IV, u/sd visited Panchayat Talwara lower w.e.f. 02/11/2022 to 03/11/2022, interacted and obtained feedback from the people of the panchayat so as to bolster efforts of the Government in improving delivery of village specific services.

Following are the assessments made by the u/sd along-with the interventions/ suggestions in the matter.

- 1. There are works/demands raised by the people of the panchayat during first phase of Back to Village which are still not addressed even after the elapse of more then 4 years. The demands like flood protection work and construction of road from main road to Govt. Middle school KansBrahmana (1.5 km) need to be fulfilled at the earliest without any further dilly-dallying.
- 2. Erratic power supply is undermining the effective services deliveries for which the people raised demand for receiving station in the panchayat.
- 3. Since the panchayat is on the bank of mighty River Chinab, there is huge scope of tourism. In order to achieve the target many spots of the area can be developed into picnic spots like the area near Shiv Temple which has lilting view with Chinab flowing in the background.
- 4. While interacting with the youth of the panchayat, u/sd felt uncharted enthusiasm for various sports among them but due to lack of designated playground they were not able to nourish their talent. While touring the area, there were many spots which could be developed into a playground.

Furthermore, there is urgent requirement of opening of CSC centre, health centre, post office, Animal Husbandry Centre and an additional building at Govt Middle School at Kansbrahmana.

Finally, the overall development activities in the panchayat are in progress and there is evident cordial relation with the frontline workers and panchayat.
