| I | <p>Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Despite sufficient availability of water resources drinking water has not been made available to around Nau Chak village due to non availability of motor pump. J.E concerned intimated that few water supply pipes to said area have got broken and also the water supply pump costing around Rs.1.05 lac has been made available by the Department for the purpose. 2. The Panchayat members vehemently complained about the drug menace/ abuse in the Panchayat Marheen. In order to address the issue the undersigned on spot constituted a Committee comprising of the following. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> I. Sh. Shiv Dev Singh Chairman. II. Sh. Thoru Ram Member. III. Sh. Ganesh Dass Member. IV. Sh. Dharam Pal Member V. Sh. Ram Pal Sharma Member. <p>The Committee has been mandated to look into the issue of drug menace and apprised Executive Magistrate about the drugs sources and the people involved. The Executive Magistrate has been directed to review the progress of developmental works as well as the drug menace for further appropriate necessary action as warranted under rule in the said panchayat fortnightly by taking the stake holder/ officer accountable.</p> 3. Second installment in favour of the persons constructing their houses under PMAY (R) has not been received. 4. Honorarium in favour of GRS has not been released for last eight months. Also the honorarium of the Aanganwadi workers has not been released. 5. Panchayat members complained that none of the works proposed under B2V3 have been executed. 6. Panchayat and the local people complained that though the Degree College was sanctioned for Marheen but on ground the execution work is being carried at Raj Bagh which is far away from the Border area as well as the Panchayat Marheen which shall not serve the purpose of the poor people of Marheen and its adjoining border areas. The Gram Sabha forcefully requested for establishment of the said sanctioned college at Marheen as was sanctioned earlier. 7. Panchayat as well as the local civil society complained that there is no principal in Govt. Higher Secondary School Marheen for the last one year which need to be posted on priority. |

Indoor Stadium/Playground facility for the local youth demanding from B2V1 onwards has not seen light of the day.

Panchayat Marheen is having sufficient fertile land suitable for growing various types of crops and vegetables more importantly Basmati rice, however during the visit to the said Panchayat various important issues were raised by the Panchayat members, Gram Sabha and others civil society members which I feel necessary to be addressed keeping in view the importance and the urgency involved. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> I. Three halls of the building of Govt. Girls High School constructed approximately around 50-60 years back are in dilapidated condition and on inspecting the premises on spot found that running classes in the said premises is dangerous and not wise enough to do so. Upon this Tehsildar Marheen was directed to get the safety audit of the said halls conducted and furnish estimates for their reconstruction to the District Development Commissioner Kathua for further appropriate necessary action. Similarly the Govt. Middle School Nau Chak has a building some part of which is in dilapidated condition not worthy of being housed by students and Tehsildar Marheen was on spot directed to take immediate steps as in case of Govt. Girls High School Marheen above. II. Marheen is the central point connecting national highway and the border belt is having very poor health care infrastructure in terms of building as well as man power/practitioner. This PHC also catering the needs of the border forces is lacking in terms of the following which are of utmost importance and need to be addressed on urgency basis. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Despite having two posts of Medical Officers in the Primary Health Centre Marheen no Allopathic Doctors has been posted in the said PHC for the last eight years however one Ayurvedic Doctors and few Paramedical staff is running the hospital. The hospital building is in a very bad condition and not worthy of housing patients as the roof and walls are in a bad condition where the roots of plants which have come up over the years on the roof top have penetrated inside the rooms. No repairment work has been carried and during rains the entire water from around the building enters the hospital building. b) The Primary School at Masha mohalla Marheen with enrollment of 32 students with two teachers is located adjoining a culvert and the small children has to cross the same among bushes which is a water logged area and during floods it becomes very dangerous for the children the cross over. The Panchayat, school teachers and the locals demanded immediate fencing of the school and also construction of washroom/kitchen for the students. c) The demand of the people for creating playground/sports facility at Marheen projected since B2V1 is an another important demand keeping in view the potential of the youth in the area and need to be met with, which shall create healthy environment as well as sporting spirit. Tehsildar Marheen has been directed to identify suitable state land and project the issue before the District Development Commissioner Kathua for redressal through the concerned department. d) The scarcity of drinking water for around 150 households of Nau Chak as conveyed by the Panchayat from the bore well needs to be restored immediately so that the local inhabitants could not be made to fetch drinking water from the said bore well after covering a distance of more than 1 KM on foot.




