GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

II	Major/ urgent public demands that was/ were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far: 1.Shortage / irregular supply of water / tap water was reflected. 2. Maintenance of internal roads. 3. Requirement of road from railway road to Karyani Mohalla.
III	Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions: (The visiting officer to ensure that the overall assessment is recorded in details along with concrete suggestions) The people of the area are well aware of the Govt Schemes and have availed the benefits of these schemes. The issues raised during previous B2V programmes are not substantially addressed. Though individual beneficiary schemes have percolated to the more eligible beneficiaries. The most heated demand of the panchayat is regarding irregular and insufficient water supply. Besides road connectivity to certain villages are urgently required. Suggestions: The demands projected under GPDP must be shared with the HOD's of concerned departments, so that they can be projected under UT Capex of that very sector. The fulfillment of any / all demands built the trust of PRI's with Government.

3 Tractor Road from Naki Chowk to Dansoo (Bhim Sen Devta): There is no permanent groad to the fields of the villages near the sacred place of 8him Sen Devta. Everytime for ploughing their fields they have to cross other villager's fields. So It's a request to provide them direct tractor Road to there fields and solve this issue.

Grates For Flood Control: - There is a major problem of flood to the houses and fields of the villagers living near the khad (Rask Ka Nalla). During winter seasonheavy flood is observed every year, which causes risk to the lives of the people living nearby the khad. So it's a request to provide grates to resolve this issue.

5. Reparing Of Pipes: People living in W. No. 4 are suffering from the shortage of the drinking water. From last 15 years, there is no replacement of the pipes to fulfil the drinking water needs. As there is increase in population, so to cope with this problem we request you to place pipes of more water supply capacity then the pipes used in past supply system.

6. Requirement of 30 No. of electric poles and repairing of electricity wires in W.No. 4:- There is the shortage of the electricity poles in Ward No. 4. The repairing of the electric wires must also be done as no repair work is done from past so many years. Due to this electricity loses are occurring and there is the shortage of the electricity supply due to loses at the junction and breakings.

7. Requirement of Hand pump in W.No. 4:- Due to the shortage of the water in W.No. 4 for drinking, washing and other household or domestic activities. I request you on

behalf of my ward members to provide us 3 hand pumps in my ward.


