GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas

General assessment of visiting officer

Any major Complaint brought to the notice of visiting officer

(a) The major Complaint brought to the notice of visiting officer during the visit was regarding the working of PHE department. The higher officers of the Concern department rarely visit the field and are unaware about the general level difficulty faced by the inhabitants of the panchayat. There is a shortage of water supply in the Panchayat halqa and even after taking up the issue with concerned AEE, yet nothing has been done so far as the redressal of their grievance are concerned.

(b) Construction of road from Majoor to Jallara via Panchayat Ghar, and road from Sandal to Patel. Konesi to gonni (Jhangh) during the visit under B2V4, the general public and village members of Panchayat halqa raised various Complaints, regarding the working of PMGSY. The upgradation. The up-gradation work was taken up during the year 2019, however even after the laps of four year, no road has been upgraded.

(c) Complaint against revenue department.

The member of the village Panchayat and general public raised voice against the revenue officers and officials. NO revenue office ever visit the Panchayat halqa even at the time of Girdawri no Patwari come in the field.

(2) Major urgent public demands that was/were reflected earlier but not have been addressed so far.

(a) There is no PHE building and deployment of doctor and staff as per norms and requirement of ambulance.

(b) Construction of internal link roads in the Panchayat.

(c) Requirement of Bank Branch and veterinary hospital.

(3) Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:

As the Panchayat falls in far flung area of District Jammu the working of various departmental activities is halted due to bad road connectivities/condition.

People of The Panchyat halqa are not happy with the pace of work of various government departments especially revenue, PDD, PHE and R3B.

→ There is a great need of renovation of building of high School Jhangh, and one Physical Teacher in the School
Suggestion:

- (1) Completion of previous pending works/building must be done at the earliest by providing with funding required
- (2) Officers of the Revenue, PDD, and PHE must be directed to visit The Panchyat on regular basis so as to assess the condition on ground and take suitable measure for grievance redressal of the public.
- (3) Construction work of road must be taken on top priority as all other developmental activities are directly related to it.
- (4) Renovation of high school Jhangh.
