





GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDC official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

A) Incomplete Buildings / projects.

- 1) Sheik Husaini Building - The work on the said building was started in the year 2000, till date the workers reached up to slab level. Toilets work and plastering work is pending which stands stalled and expected to be completed in the financial year owing to the availability of funds.
 - 2) New Type Primary Health Center - The work on the said project was better known as one left. of the building is completed and handed over to health dept, the health dept will function well ultimately benefit the local citizens.
 - 3) JIM Scheme Ration Card Scheme - The work on the said project is in full swing, note the D.R.M.D RFP is about 65% completed, the Health and Sanitary Dept are appreciating the vigorous efforts of the Dept in achieving the milestones and early implementation of the scheme. The scheme will ease out the citizens with requirements of the area. This was first priority demands in previous B.P.L.
- B) Primary Health Centre - The building of PHC is old and is in starting conditions with old equipment. The centre is lacking 24x7 health services. Also in former curriculum a body affecting the patient care. The PHC should have been furnished with some proper backup and also a strategic staff functioning. Appointing a dental surgeon and ECG laboratory the centre is lacking many and very facility. However there is an ECG machine but without an operator.

C) My School My pride

There are three schools in the village of Piplajip, one middle school and a High School besides two private primary schools. The schools lack basic facilities of drinking water supply and separate sanitation facility for girls. The schools lack proper fencing. There should be proper basic facilities besides increasing the no. of teachers. Also the schools lack in a basketball court and other games facilities. Meeting capacity of the school buildings is not sufficient to accommodate present student rate.

D) Panchayat Playing Ground

The village has a special playground, but needs protection from encroachment side to avoid crowd/land slides. Further fencing has to be provided to avoid damage due to animal grazing. A toilet facility and changing place has been demand by the locals. A sports ground was provided long back by the locals. At all the trees were cut. The sports items like football, basketball and chess was provided senior citizens of the

i) Mores Complaints

1) The visiting officer was informed about the slippage free of work or lack of motivation which has been funded under PRIS grants. Also in 17 the passing through Bokham to Rallam pass through fields which quite frequently damage body wearing/snow clothes, at the area seems damaged and there is a need for rectification of the area. The people demand the TDS committee be charged from works and labour - changes - between all along the fence road. Also non availability of lady doctor or permanent busies, dental surgeon and a lab technician brought into the notice. Pending Humanization of AWH and shortage of materials, poor insulation scarce.

ii) Manufacturing Power Generation Do. Not Progress

It was brought into notice that nothing may expect about the prioritized but were not addressed.

- 1) Uninterrupted Power supply and further reduction in power backlog from june.
- 2) Rallam to Anjantha connectivity through bridge
- 3) Provision for Higher Secondary
- 4) Sports stadium.
- 5) Sub-District hospital with 200 bed capacity.

iii) Overall Assessment of Trip Visit

The overall participation of locals during the trip visit was very poor only 11 out of 500 persons attended the same. There seems to be large information communication gap b/w the local masses and PRIS. No state press or going preference to basic amenities like drinking water supply and power supply. At the depths one putting their efforts in making Helga a better place to live, particularly the works of JEDD and PWD are appreciated by the all in Helga, some funded by Arunachal Handicraft, Corporation and social welfare are funded by ex-servicemen in the Helga. But the second but unawareness of the schemes funded by the government on this regard the depths pledged to work in congruence and come at the front in sanitizing the local masses. It was also suggested to contact Govt. Department officials for getting a loan to understand the procedure for applying for a further scheme.
