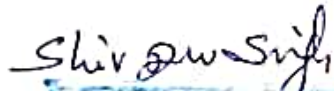

Major Complaints of Panchayat Gharink

Inhabitants of Panchayat are facing severe crisis of drinking water as there is only one working tubewell for the whole Panchayat. There is urgent requirement of one more tubewell and double motor electromechanical water pumping system to meet their genuine and long pending demand.

- 2) PHC should be established in the panchayat.
- 3) There is no playground and library in the Panchayat, so there is urgent need of both playground and library in panchayat.
- 4) Lane drain condition is worse and need urgent solution.
- 5) Insufficient funds leads to delay in the Panchayat work, so more funds should be provided.
- 6) Renovation of buildings, boundary walls and proper drinking water facilities in the schools of the Panchayat.
- 7) Construction of 1.5km road is highly required in Ward No. 3 from Peer Baba to Water tank stage 1 Rupari.
- 8) Urgent Requirement of installation of underground water Hand pumps (2 Nos) in Ward No. 6 in the panchayat.

Major Public Demands

Major Demands put forward earlier and not addressed so far :-

- 1) Tubewell and double motor electromechanical water pumping system
- 2) Primary Health centre
- 3) Library and Playground in the Panchayat.
- 4) Development/upgradation of Sajwal Park and Pond in Ward No. 5

Overall Assessment of the visit and suggestions:-

- Only one tubewell is working for whole Panchayat Peoples are facing crisis of drinking water and Their genuine problem can be overcome by sanctioning of one more tubewell, electromechanical double motor water pumping system and handpumps.
- 2) There is no library and playground in the Panchayat. Drug abuse and addiction is the major concern and to engage the students and youth, there must be a playground and library in the Panchayat.
- 3) There must be a PHC in the Panchayat. Further to take care of animals too, there must be a veterinary hospital, as Lumpy disease is very much prevalent in the Panchayat.
- 4) Lack of funds hampering the overall development of the Panchayat, so more funds should be given to the Panchayat for the development of Anant sarovars, and parks so that important recreational sites can be constructed in the Panchayat.
- 5) Four sites in the Panchayat can be recognized for the tourism that can be beneficial for the peoples viz. 200 years old Hanuman temple, Peer Baba Nagzi's Kley ziarat, Mai Malchani ziarat Kalorma and Shiv temple & Park. More funds should be given for the development.
