While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.

15(b). Four sars were shown in the village viz. Pir Sar,Gujjar Sar, fish pond in the land of Jaffar Hussain Shah and water harvesting pond of Ab Rashid khan. The Teachers of middle school near pir Sar demanded for fencing of this sar as the children of this school use the bund of this Sar for coming to the school and back movement to home. The fish pond in the land of Jaffar Hussain has not been properly conceived and lies adjacent to the road and can pose threat when completely filled with water. Gujjar Sar needs de-siltation as also requested by the inhabitants.

- 2. Panchayat Ghar is without the facility of water, electricity and internet which are basic requirements for its proper functioning. The bathroom in the panchayat Ghar is not functional and needs immediate repairs and up-gradation. The Panchayat Ghar needs to be fenced.
- 3.The villagers are being supplied raw water as also reported by the employees of Jal Shakti Department. There remains scarcity of water during autmn and winter.The people demanded for construction of a filitration plant and supply of water on regular basis.The village is being covered under JJM as reported by the Exn concerned.
- 4. Shortage of Electricity poles and transmission line in some areas was reported and also verified.
- 5. The villagers demanded for macadamization of some inner road links.
