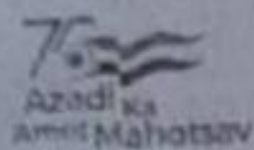

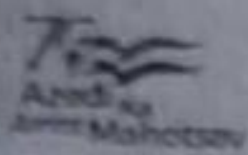

Education Department: Required upgradation of government middle school Grant to High School so that better education facilities can be available by the inhabitants of the area especially the girls of the remotest end of the Panchayat.

Requirement of Urdu teacher and physics instructor highly demanded.

PDD Department: As the poles are not available the wires are hanging on the trees and wooden planks so its always a risk. Proper steel poles nearly 500 required in the area. A requirement of transformers of 250, as the panchayatghar does not have an electric connection.

Flood Control Department: Create work near the house of Bashir Ahmed S/o Mir Hussain and other areas of Grant Nargarha and Shana Panchayat. Create work of Kharota Nallah. Create work at Nagrada near Nallah S. Nallah Kharthil. Create work at Kambal Khaad to Patta.

PHE Department: Water scarcity is the reason of Hue and Cry in back to village program. The water facility from Ranjan tubewell by installing a transformer or initiating a new tubewell in the panchayat by installing a new tubewell, Moreover old pipes are to be replaced.

Soil Conservation Department / Agriculture Department: Climate change has done good job but still repair and renovation of ponds mentioned as:



→ Repair / Renovation of Pond at Shawa ward No-1

→ Repair / Renovation of Pond at Grant ward No-8

→ Repair / Renovation of Pond at Higari ward No-6

→ Repair of Pond at Patta Ward No-5

Except it, some more new ponds were demanded for the area so that in summer season animal folk as well as human can get water for irrigation purposes.

Health Department: Land stands identified so a building of Health to be created and an ambulance to be provided which is a long pending demand. The rural development needs three more ICOS centres, Anganwadis to fetch the basic needs of the area.

R.D.D : Nearly 18 cases of IPA which were dropped but found genuine were recommended for reconsideration; new pathways or tractor roads demanded each and every ward. Some schemes of MGNREGA were demanded in every ward and were written or mentioned in the meeting register.

→ Construction of road from Shawa pond to Mohalla Phool ward No-1

→ Construction of road from Mohalla Mohd Yaq. Qaab to Mohalla Barket Ali

→ Construction of road from Shawa mata to Growatechok ward No-9


