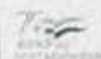

- ① Construction of permanent bunkers to seek shelter during the firing at border by neighbour country at firing erupt frequently.
- ② Land occupied by military needs to be compensated according to its suitability.
- ③ Time slot of Army gate needs to be increase upto 10 hrs (7am to 5pm) so the people can perform agriculture activities on the land located in the buffer zone.
- ④ Problem of waterlogging due to choking of natural drainage. Drainage channels across the water barrier/land constituted by Army for protection should be increase to allow free flow of water.
- ⑤ Installation of water pipelines connection to individual households.
- ⑥ Construction of shamslai ghat shed with bathing ghat.
- ⑦ Electric poles & wires need to be installed in agriculture land for irrigation purpose.
- ⑧ During visit I found Amrit Sarovar (2 ponds) in ward no-1 & ward no-6 which need to be revive by dredging, desilting & deweeding, further embankment need to cover it around.
- ⑨ organic farming need to be promote by agriculture department.
- ⑩ open dumping of waste need to be check by using or promoting alternate methods like Composting, Vermicomposting.
- ⑪ Plantation should be done by social forestry along the banks of canal & road side.

- (12) Black topping of Kharota to Kulia road highly needed.
- (13) Urgently 6 culverts need to be constructed in the panchayat in different wards.
- (14) A government piece of land is available in the ward no-9 which should be developed into a community park.
- (15) To earn the income entrepreneurship courses such as silage, centre, mushroom cultivation, apiculture, sericulture, floriculture etc need to be initiated and promoted by the concerned departments.
- (16) Construction / developing of common sitting place / village chabutra in the panchayat ward no-2 under banyan tree, so that people can organize discussion, open meeting, especially senior citizens / elders.
- (17) Complaint against revenue deptt, that no patwar or patwar khana is available in the panchayat.
- (18) During my visit in middle school sauth, I found a bunker available in the school premises in poor condition, need renovation & maintenance at urgent.
