








GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- 7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

Vandana Kumari. All the PRIs were present at the Sabha. Ladies from SHGs, ICDS dept and general public attended the Sabha. The proceedings of the Sabha are listed below:

- i) The visiting officer stressed on how the role of women has evolved over the years and how they can contribute in building a healthy and better society.
- ii) Various schemes and programmes run by the Govt. for pregnant and unemployed women were discussed during the sabha.



Observations B2V4

During the B2V4 full participation of the PRI Members was seen. B2V is getting better understanding with the public with the passing years. As marked, B2V4 in Flora Nagbani Panchayat was overall a well-organized programme .I appreciate female Sarpanch Smt. Vandana Kumari for her motivation for women who organized and conducted the B2V4 Programme in a befitting manner. It is very satisfying to see well qualified and enterprising persons like Preety, managing the affairs of Panchayat.

The school education and ICDS departments are delivering in best possible manner. Involvement of school staff could be seen in promoting holistic development of children. Feedback was given by the public regarding teachers of GPS Ladore taking care of personal hygiene of children besides curricular and extra curricular activities.

Demand for public transport in certain unattended areas was loud and one of the prominent route in this regard from Punnu di hatti needs to be connected via Domana to Jewel chowk for convenience of college students and women .

There is a scope for formulation of good tourism plan in this panchyat with an active involvement of departments of Irrigation and Flood Control, Horticulture and Tourism. This panchayat has an ancient temple of Nag devta which is deeply revered by the locals. It has historic significance and there is great footfall in the melas held during Shivratri and Nag Panchmi in this temple. This temple has a huge chunk of land associated with it which is a deep forest and undisturbed. Its status need to be preserved. This historic temple has an Amritsarovar in its vicinity, as such this place along with orchards of citrus fruits if developed by the horticulture department and canals running along the length and breadth of this panchayat if maintained and kept clean by the Irrigation and Flood control department could make this panchayat a big tourist attraction. This panchayat has an added advantage of being well connected with Jammu city besides being clean and green.

There needs to be door to door collection of solid waste as in municipal areas. For liquid waste management scheme of soakage pits has been well taken by the people.

As Panchayats are symbol of people's power at grass-root level and beacon of our strong democracy, it is my suggestion that buildings of panchayat-ghar should be tastefully made / well renovated with all the modern facilities.

Lack of awareness regarding many CSS /UT Schemes has been noticed among public. My suggestion is for organizing frequent session for PRI members at Panchayat level to make them well versed in these schemes.

As the government functioning has started shifting towards e-governance our PRI members need to be educated /trained in operating these digital applications.


After taking the feedback from the public during informal meetings with senior citizens, youth and during Bal Sabha and Mahila Sabha I wish to recommend following demands to be full filled on priority:

- a) Bathing Ghat for ladies near Cremation Shed, Flora Nagbani
- b) Requirement of 2 additional rooms at GPS Ladore
- c) Construction of lane drain from main road to Mohinder House W.No. 4 & 5
- d) Construction of lane drain from House of Bishan Dass to House of Pawan W.No.5
- e) Requirement of Public transport from Punnu di Hatti to Jewel via Damana
- f) Requirement of Handpump at Ladore

During the awareness discourse on drug addiction, it was observed that people are not opening up for discussion. I suggest that there must be a good and approachable mechanism in place for rehabilitation of an addict as people are generally unaware of the action to be taken once they identify an addict. Institutions for their re-habilitation should be established in large number and treatment should be free of cost. Police department should hold frequent interaction with civil society members on different crime and anti-social activities. A good response for RDD Schemes in the Panchayat was seen including JKRLM which has been well received by the people.

Employment department needs to be more proactive.
